Mission

To promote the Career Center to the University campus and to employers through promotions and activities

Purpose and Responsibility

- I. To develop an understanding and to utilize the current services and programs offered by the Career Center
- II. To advise the Career Center regarding matters brought before the Board
- III. To provide students serving on the board with an opportunity to ask questions and address issues
- IV. To promote the Career Center to other students on campus through various activities
- V. To remain in good standing with the Ambassador Board by accumulating a minimum of (30) activity points

Membership

The board shall be composed of no fewer than 14 appointed members including: 3 freshmen, 3 sophomores, 3 juniors, 3 seniors, 1 graduate student, 1 representative from the Student Body President's Office and representatives from the Career Center staff.

Terms shall be for a period of two years with the option of re-appointment.

Meetings

The board will meet three times per semester (unless otherwise stated).
