A growing university

NDSU is a land-grant university accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, with an enrollment of more than 13,200 students. In research expenditures, NDSU ranks 128th among 662 universities in the United States and 41st for institutions without a medical school. Education resources for NDSU students include cutting-edge technology and a highly educated faculty with 71 percent of all faculty members holding the highest degrees in their fields. NDSU is part of the Tri-College University, which allows students enrolled at NDSU to take courses at Concordia College and Minnesota State University Moorhead at no additional cost.

A thriving community

NDSU is located on the eastern edge of North Dakota in Fargo, the state's largest community. With its sister city, Moorhead, Minn., directly across the Red River, Fargo forms one of the largest metropolitan centers between Minneapolis and Seattle. Fargo was named one of the cleanest cities in the country by the American Lung Association's "State of the Air" 2008 report and listed eighth in the "25 Best Markets to Find a Job" released by MSN and CareerBuilder.com.
