



Study Abroad in Uganda (MICR 793 or MICR 379) Information Sheet

Date: June 6 - July 4, 2009

Trip Information:

This course involves international travel to Uganda and is delivered in a format involving lectures from international experts and field trips. All students will learn about:

- A broad range of tropical animal production systems in a developing country.
- Unique animal health challenges under tropical conditions.
- Local and global disease surveillance systems from a perspective of a 'foreign disease' endemic country.
- Control programs for important human and animal disease epidemics in a developing country.
- Public Health Practice in Uganda.
- Food Safety Practice in a tropical setting.

This field study experience has been determined to be most effective based on maximum number of 10 students. Enrollment will be based on first come basis. A \$300 non-refundable deposit course fee will be due March 31, 2009.

Cost:

Course fee: \$3000 + tuition.

The tuition for the trip will be as follows:

- MICR 379 - 3 Undergraduate credits - \$778.26 tuition
- MICR 793 - 3 Graduate credits - \$825.90 tuition
- \$300 non-refundable deposit due March 31, 2009
- Travel and incidentals are at students own additional expense
