CONTEST RULES: SAME AS THE STATE CONTESTS, EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

1. 4-H will not require State Dress Code.
2. 4-H will have two divisions. Junior and Senior Divisions will be the same as the state guidelines. Junior (8-13 as of September 1, 2009) Senior (13-18 as of September 1, 2009)
3. Teams are made up of 3-5 members from the same FFA Chapter. Co-oping of 4-H teams between counties will be allowed, following state rules. The top three scores will comprise the team scores, except in the Ag. Sales contest, in which the top four scores will comprise the team score.
4. Performance records may be used in the livestock judging contest.
5. A paper keep/cull class will be used. (beef, swine, or sheep)

AWARDS:

4-H Individuals: Sr. & Jr.: Plaques for the top three individuals.
Individual ribbons for the top 50% of the contestants.

4-H Teams: Sr. & Jr.: Plaque for the top team.

FFA Individuals: Five high individual plaques. Individual gold, silver, bronze ribbons.

FFA Teams: Three high team plaques. Team gold, silver, bronze rosettes.

A \$5.00 registration fee will be assessed to each participant and coach to cover the cost of awards and lunch. A lunch will be served by the Carrington FFA Alumni at the Carrington High School.
