Observations and trends:

1. While traditional community 4-H club enrollment is declining, a reversal on total enrollment seems to be the trend with added special interest clubs, military clubs, and after-school clubs.
2. The gender mix in club enrollment still favors female at 59% compared to 40% male.
3. The program areas are grouped by ES codes, not specific or individual "project" areas.
