

# Richard H. Barry Hall FAQs

The following questions have been raised by students at various meetings regarding Barry Hall. If you have additional questions about the new College of Business building, please contact us using the 'Contact the College' page listed in the side menu.

## Computers and Technology Questions:

- Are there laptop checkouts?
  - No
- Are there going to be print stations?
  - Yes. There will be 4 print stations; one on each floor of the classroom building and one in the computer cluster. This will include at least one color printer.
- Will there be wireless internet?
  - Yes. Richard H. Barry Hall has more wireless capabilities than any building on campus.
- Will there be an ATM?
  - Yes

## Transportation Questions:

- Will there be bike racks?
  - Yes!
- Will there be visitor parking?
  - Yes, however, there is very little and it is NOT for student use. These spots are reserved for guest speakers, interviewing faculty, and other guests who are visiting.
- Will there be student parking?
  - No
- Will there be a bus route?
  - YES!!! MAT bus route 33 will stop at RHB every 10 to 12 minutes. Also route 13 A&B will stop at Barry Hall. There will even be a monitor near the entrance where you can see a countdown until the next bus arrives.

## **Other Questions:**

- Are there lockers for students to put their stuff in?
  - No, for security purposes.
- Will there be a business library on site?
  - Yes, there will be a NDSU library branch.
- Can we schedule meeting spaces for studying, clubs, or other organizations?
  - Yes. Please see the Student Organizations Advisor.
- Can we post event details and opportunities?
  - Yes. You can post event information on the LCD screens. These must be approved by the Dean's Office. No other posting will be available.
- Will there be the posting Kiosks available (like the 3 sided one's on campus)?
  - Not at this time. Student Government is discussing this possibility at this time.
- What kind, if any, of security is available in and around the building?
  - There will be security cameras that will monitor the building at all times. There will also be security personnel available.

## **Building Hours of Operation:**

- Saturday: Closed
- Sunday: Closed
  - Offices will be open Monday—Friday from 8 am to 5 pm
