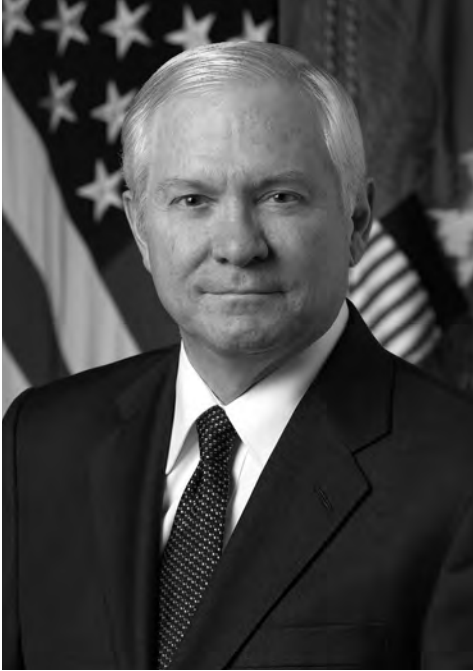

DR. ROBERT M. GATES, *United States Secretary of Defense*

Dr. Robert M. Gates was sworn in on December 18, 2006, as the 22nd Secretary of Defense. Dr. Gates is the only Secretary of Defense in U.S. history to be asked to remain in that office by a newly-elected President. President Barack Obama is the eighth president Dr. Gates has served.

Before entering his present post, Dr. Gates was the President of Texas A&M University, the nation's seventh largest university. In 2004, he hired Bresciani from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to serve as Vice President of Student Affairs at Texas A&M. Prior to assuming the Texas A&M presidency in 2002, Gates served as Interim Dean of the George Bush School of Government and Public Service at Texas A&M from 1999 to 2001.

"Secretary Gates exemplifies a career of selfless service to our country at a level with few parallels, and through the course of his tenure leading Texas A&M University, became a broadly respected higher education leader," Bresciani said. "We are honored that North Dakota State University's graduates will have the opportunity to hear from such a notable patriot, scholar and public servant."

Dr. Gates joined the Central Intelligence Agency in 1966 and spent nearly 27 years as an intelligence professional. During that period, he spent nearly nine years at the National Security Council, The White House, serving four presidents of both political parties.

Dr. Gates served as Director of Central Intelligence from 1991 until 1993. He is the only career officer in CIA's history to rise from entry-level analyst to Director. He served as Deputy Director of Central Intelligence from 1986 until 1989 and as Assistant to the President and Deputy National Security Adviser at the White House from January 20, 1989, until November 6, 1991, for President George H.W. Bush.

Secretary Gates has been awarded the National Security Medal, the Presidential Citizens Medal, has twice received the National Intelligence Distinguished Service Medal, and has three times received CIA's highest award, the Distinguished Intelligence Medal.

He is the author of the memoir, *From the Shadows: The Ultimate Insider's Story of Five Presidents and How They Won the Cold War*, published in 1996.

While President of Texas A&M University, Gates also served as Chairman of the Independent Trustees of The Fidelity Funds, the nation's largest mutual fund company, and on the board of directors of NACCO Industries, Inc., Brinker International, Inc. and Parker Drilling Company, Inc.

Secretary Gates also has served on the Board of Directors and Executive Committee of the American Council on Education, the Board of Directors of the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges, and the National Executive Board of the Boy Scouts of America. He has also been President of the National Eagle Scout Association.

A native of Wichita, Kansas, Secretary Gates received his bachelor's degree from the College of William and Mary, his master's degree in history from Indiana University, and his doctorate in Russian and Soviet history from Georgetown University.

DR. DEAN L. BRESCIANI, *President*

Dean L. Bresciani was named North Dakota State University's 14th president on May 24, 2010. Bresciani is well known for his dedication to students and regarded for his thoughtfulness, energy and integrity. He brings to campus the knowledge and experience of a nearly 30-year higher education career and has developed a broad leadership base in the academic, administrative and political aspects of higher education.

Bresciani is a native of Napa Valley, Calif. Before coming to NDSU, he was vice president for student affairs at Texas A&M University in College Station, Texas, from 2004 to 2008, where he also was a professor of educational administration. He held similar administrative and faculty roles at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill from 1998 to 2004, and a faculty appointment at North Carolina State University. Bresciani has served in administrative and faculty positions at seven other universities around the nation, as well as serving as a research analyst for a state university system.

Through his career, Bresciani has gained an extensive background in strategic planning, enrollment management, facilities design and financing, auxiliary enterprises operation and implementation of business operation efficiencies and revenue enhancement measures. A focus of his work is enhancing the accessibility and quality of campus programs while improving the sense of welcome, support and achievement for all members of the university and surrounding communities.

Bresciani earned his bachelor's degree in sociology from Humboldt State University, Arcata, Calif.; master's degree in college student personnel from Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio; and doctorate in higher education finance, with a doctoral minor in economics, from the University of Arizona in Tucson, Ariz.

Bresciani has an array of invited and juried publications and presentations, and broad involvement in higher education associations ranging from scholarly to business affairs. He has held national leadership positions, including past Council Chair of the Association of Public and Land-grant Universities, and service on the board of directors in the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators. He also has professional affiliations with the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education, EDUCAUSE, and the National Association of College and University Business Officers.

He has received numerous honors, including Administrator of the Year in 2008 by Texas A&M University's Student Government. He also received the Newsmaker Image Award in 2007 from the Texas A&M Division of Marketing and Communications. Bresciani was named a "Pillar of the Profession" by the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators and received the Foundations of Excellence Award from the Association of College and University Housing Officers-International.

Baumann also was in Opera Theatre, The Statesmen and Men's Ensemble. He participated in Residence Hall Government, the Student North Dakota Education Association, the Collegiate American Choral Directors Association and CMENC: The National Association for Music Education.

Baumann plans to find a full-time position in his own music classroom and to teach private voice lessons.



RECOGNITION OF FACULTY EXCELLENCE

WALDRON AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN RESEARCH

Verlin B. Hinsz, *Professor of Psychology*

Hinsz conducts leading research in the social and informational factors that facilitate and hinder motivation, decision-making and performance. He earned his bachelor's degree at NDSU, and master's degree and doctorate at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign. He joined the NDSU faculty in 1983.

ODNEY AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

Gregory Cook, *Professor and Chair of Chemistry and Biochemistry*

Cook is a highly regarded educator who has taught more than 3,200 students since joining the NDSU faculty in 1996. He earned his bachelor's degree at Olivet College and master's degree and doctorate at Michigan State University. Cook also was a National Institutes of Health fellow at Stanford University.

PELTIER AWARD FOR INNOVATION IN TEACHING

Dean Knudson, *Associate Professor of Computer Science*

Knudson transformed NDSU's computer science capstone course into a "learn-by-doing" experience using modern tools and methods borrowed from regional companies for real projects. He earned his bachelor's degree at Concordia College, master's degree at Bowling Green State University and doctorate at Northwestern University. He joined the NDSU faculty in 2004.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DISTINGUISHED FACULTY SERVICE AWARD

Herbert W. Snyder, *Associate Professor of Accounting and Information Systems*

Snyder joined the NDSU faculty in 2003, and is considered one of the leading forensic accounting educators in the country. A Fulbright Scholar in the Ukraine during 2003, he received the 2010 Fraud Educator of the Year Award from the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners. Snyder earned his bachelor's degree at Babson College and doctorate from Syracuse University.

SERVICE-LEARNING AWARD

Nancy Kaler, *Senior Lecturer of Human Development and Family Science*

Kaler cultivates relationships with approximately 75 agencies, while arranging and supervising field experience placements for the Department of Human Development and Family Science. Kaler joined NDSU in 1987, and earned her bachelor's and master's degrees at the University of North Dakota.



ENDOWED PRESIDENTIAL PROFESSORSHIPS

JORDAN A. ENGBERG PRESIDENTIAL PROFESSORSHIP

Charlene Wolf-Hall, assistant dean for the College of Graduate and Interdisciplinary Studies and professor of veterinary and microbiological sciences, earned her bachelor's and master's degrees in microbiology from South Dakota State University, Brookings, and her doctorate in food science and technology from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln. The Engberg professorship is awarded to faculty at the rank of professor with at least eight years of service to NDSU and a balanced academic record of excellence in teaching, research and service.

DALE HOGOBOOM PRESIDENTIAL PROFESSORSHIP

Canan Bilen-Green, professor of industrial and manufacturing engineering, earned bachelor's degrees in statistics and industrial engineering from Middle East Technical University and Bilkent University, both in Turkey. She earned a master's degree and doctorate at the University of Wyoming, Laramie. The Hogoboom professorship is awarded to faculty at the rank of professor with at least eight years of service to NDSU and a balanced academic record of excellence in teaching, research and service.

WALTER F. AND VERNA GERHTS PRESIDENTIAL PROFESSORSHIP

Wenfang Sun, associate professor of chemistry and biochemistry, earned a bachelor's in chemistry from Wuhan University, China; a doctorate in chemistry from the Institute of Photographic Chemistry, Chinese Academy of Sciences, Beijing; and did postdoctoral work at the University of Alabama, Birmingham. The Gerhts professorship is for faculty at the associate professor rank with at least five years of service.



ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

William Brown, BS '54, civil engineering, distinguished himself in the engineering field by playing a vital role in the aerospace industry, primarily with the development of the Apache attack helicopter for U.S. and allied military services. Brown spent the first 25 years of his career with the Boeing Co. working in the military aircraft division where he specialized in the design, development and testing of aircraft and spacecraft. He joined Hughes Helicopters in 1980, where he was responsible for the development of the AH-64 Apache. When McDonnell Douglas Corp. acquired Hughes Helicopters in 1984, Brown was named vice president of engineering and eventually appointed president. He remained in that position until retiring in 1990. After retirement, Brown served for seven years as an adviser to the Secretary of the Army as a member for the Army Science Board.

Dan Noble, BArch '82, architecture, BA '81, architecture and architecture studies, is principal/director of design of HKS Inc., one of the top 10 architectural firms in the world. Under Noble's guidance, HKS has become widely recognized as a national leader in the practice of healthcare architecture as well as design of hospitality and sports venues throughout the world. During the past five years, Noble has received more than 50 design awards. He is a thought leader on conceptual design, evidence-based design and healing environments. With Noble at the helm, HKS has completed construction projects totaling more than \$50 billion in 985 cities in 47 states and 59 foreign countries. He often lectures at national symposiums and conferences and is regularly featured in national publications. Noble serves on the advisory board for the NDSU architecture program.



HENRY L. BOLLEY ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

John F. Anderson, BS, '57, zoology, MS '59, entomology, and PhD from the University of Illinois, is a distinguished scientist at the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station in New Haven, Conn. He has written more than 280 scientific manuscripts in medical, veterinary, forest and general entomology. For the past 25 years, Anderson focused his research on emerging infectious diseases of humans and veterinary animals associated with mosquitoes and ticks. He led the successful effort in 1999 to isolate the exotic West Nile virus from mosquitoes and birds in the New World. Anderson also has worked as a lecturer and researcher at the prestigious Yale School of Medicine.



HERITAGE AWARD FOR ALUMNI SERVICE

Mike Warner, BS '72, pharmacy, and **Joanne Warner**, BS '70, physical education and French, have spent a lifetime in service to NDSU. Mike has served as an NDSU Development Foundation trustee, member of the NDSU Research Foundation board of directors, and president and member of the NDSU President's Ag Club. Joanne served on the NDSU Alumni Association board of directors, including two terms as president during the NCAA Division I transition. Mike and Joanne have been strong proponents and supporters of the NDSU Research Park, specifically with their family company, Pedigree Technologies. They are co-founders of BisonArts, a group formed to build support for the Division of Fine Arts. They helped create the BisonArts Gala, hosting the first and second annual events at their home. Now entering its fifth year, the gala is the major NDSU Fine Arts fundraising event.



HORIZON AWARD

Erik Hatch, BS '02, speech communication, is director of Homeless and Hungry, Fargo, and a realtor at Keller Williams Realty. His volunteer service and commitment to the homeless in the Fargo-Moorhead community have been outstanding. Hatch helped start the Homeless and Hungry Project, a 30-hour homeless simulation where participants fast, sleep in a cardboard box and engage in the community through worship, outreach and service. During the past five years, Homeless and Hungry has raised more than \$630,000, empowered more than 3,000 people as participants/volunteers and collected more than 100,000 pounds of donations for the local shelters. Hatch was tapped to be the food service chief for the Salvation Army during the 2010 Fargo-Moorhead flood fight. Hatch also has served as board of trustees chair for Alpha Tau Omega fraternity and as alumni adviser for the Blue Key National Honor Society.



THE ACADEMIC PROCESSIONAL

The academic processional that officially preludes the commencement ceremonies on college and university campuses is one of the oldest and most colorful customs that link 21st century education with its early origins.

To signal the achievements of their students, American institutions of higher learning conduct a formal ceremony to award the appropriate degrees earned at the conclusion of prescribed study. The action of taking the degree — baccalaureate, master's, or doctorate, as well as the designation of the day itself — is Commencement. Various explanations of the term Commencement are possible. The most likely is that centuries ago the bachelor, originally an apprentice, began an apprenticeship upon that day; and with the degree of M.A. and Ph.D., the masters and the doctors commenced their work upon the day their degrees were conferred. So today, students, having finished their preliminary education, set out upon the career for which they have prepared.

ACADEMIC APPAREL

As cited in *Academic Heraldry in America* (Sheard, 1962), the academic regalia worn at Commencement is of medieval origin. The scholars of Bologna, Salamanca, Paris, Oxford, Cambridge, Louvain, and Heidelberg dressed in a manner to distinguish themselves from the merchants and other townspeople. Since the 11th century, when the rise of the universities began, "learned clerks" robed themselves in gowns, caps, and hoods, thus marking a difference between "town and gown."

By this apparel they were recognized as belonging to the teaching guild, which was the Guild of the Master of Arts. In this organization the bachelor was the apprentice of the master. This relationship was the forerunner of today's academic structure.

Today, customs vary in different parts of the world. Generally in Europe, professors wear the type of garment customary in the university where they are lecturing. In the United States professors continue to wear the gown and hood of the university from which they received their highest degree. The gown, in origin, may have been simply a type of overcoat to protect the teacher from the cold in the unheated buildings; the cut or style seems to be derived from ecclesiastical attire. It has usually been black; however, in recent years some institutions have adopted a school color for their gowns. The gowns of bachelors and masters are usually without trimmings of any sort, whereas those of doctors are faced down the front with velvet and adorned with three velvet bars on the sleeves.

The cap or "mortarboard" may have come from the squarish cap worn by the masons of the Middle Ages, or perhaps was suggested by the shape of the books that occupied so much of the time of the scholar. Attached to a button atop the "mortarboard" is a tassel; bachelor's and master's are black or color appropriate to the subject; those of doctors are black or golden. The tassel is worn on the left side by those who are receiving or have received a degree. For photography purposes, a candidate's tassel may be worn on the right side of the mortarboard.

The hood, a triangular fold of cloth worn over the back of the gown, is faced with colors which denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree; the colors of the lining are those of the college or university by which the degree was granted. The length of the hood is correspondingly longer with each higher degree.

The wide velvet borders extending down the front of the doctoral gown, the velvet bars on the sleeves, and the borders of most hoods, are colored according to the scholarly field of the wearer. The most usual of these doctoral hood colors are the following:

While the arrangement of colors is pleasing to the eye and add beauty and impressiveness to ceremonial processions, there is historic significance attached to their selection. The white for arts and letters comes from the white fur of the Oxford and Cambridge B.A. hoods. The red for theology, as used by cardinals for centuries, follows the traditional color of the church and signifies ardent love and zeal for the faith. The purple for law comes from the royal purple of the king's courts. The green for medicine, from the stripe in the army surgeon's uniform, and earlier from the color of medicinal herbs.

The degrees in philosophy are shown by blue, the color of truth and wisdom. Science by gold-yellow, which signifies the wealth contributed

by scientific discoveries. Pink was taken from the pink brocade prescribed for the Oxford doctors of music. Olive, a shade of green, was selected for pharmacy, which is closely allied to medicine; while russet brown, the color of dress worn by old English foresters, indicates forestry.

Graduate candidates wear a hood colored according to the scholarly field of the wearer. All graduate candidates wear a black tassel. At North Dakota State University the color of the tassel signifies the college in which the undergraduate degree is earned:

UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace has an ancient history of use as a symbol of authority. Originally used by knights or a royal bodyguard to protect a king in processions, the mace evolved to assume more ceremonial functions by the 14th century. Today, as a symbol of order and authority, the NDSU mace is carried by the Stage Marshal, the presiding officer of the University Senate, before the president and other platform party dignitaries in Commencement processions. Upon reaching the stage, the mace is traditionally placed to the right of the speaker.



GRADUATION HONORS

WITH HONOR: Graduation with honor applies only to the baccalaureate degree. Graduate courses will not be included in the computation. Candidates who entered NDSU as freshmen and who have earned an institutional grade-point average greater than or equal to 3.50 and less than 3.70 will be graduated Cum Laude, an institutional grade-point average greater than or equal to 3.70 and less than 3.90 will be graduated Magna Cum Laude, and an institutional grade-point average greater than or equal to 3.90 and up to 4.0 will be graduated Summa Cum Laude. Candidates with transfer credits must meet the institutional grade-point average qualifications with the above criteria for all credits earned at NDSU, as well as a cumulative grade-point average for all credits earned including those from transfer work. All grades and all attempts of repeated courses will be included in grade-point average calculations for graduating with honor. The honor medallion is a gold medallion on a yellow ribbon and is worn around the neck. The medallion features the NDSU seal.

Other academic honors include the following:

BETA GAMMA SIGMA, *international business honor society*: A blue and gold cord is worn around the neck. Students, by class, that qualify are: juniors, top 7 percent; seniors, top 10 percent; and MBA students, top 20 percent.

BLUE KEY, *national honor society*: A blue and gold medallion with a blue ribbon is worn around the neck. Blue Key recognizes students for remarkable leadership and outstanding service to the university and the community. Academic achievement of members must be within the top 35 percent of their class.

GAMMA SIGMA DELTA, *international agriculture honor society*: A forest green and light tan honor cord is worn around the neck. Membership is conferred upon selected students who have demonstrated superior teaching, research, or service to agriculture while maintaining a 3.5 grade-point average. Members represent agricultural excellence

at the undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate levels.

GOLDEN KEY, *international honor society*: A gold medallion on a blue and gold ribbon is worn around the neck. Golden Key recognizes juniors and seniors from all disciplines who are in the top 15 percent of their class.

LAMBDA BETA HONOR SOCIETY, *national respiratory care honor society*: A forest green and black ribbon pin is worn on the gown. Members must have completed at least 50 percent of their course work and rank academically in the top 25 percent of the respiratory care class.

LAMBDA PI ETA, *national communication honorary society*: A gold cord is worn around the neck. To qualify, members must have a cumulative grade-point average of 3.0 with a 3.25 in their human or mass communication major courses.

MORTAR BOARD, *national honor society*: A gold medallion is worn around the neck. Mortar Board recognizes college seniors for distinguished ability and achievement in scholarship, leadership and service. Members must also meet at least a 3.0 grade-point average.

NATIONAL RESIDENCE HALL *Honorary*: A navy blue honor cord is worn around the neck. To qualify, members must demonstrate leadership and academic qualities within the top 1 percent of the residence hall population.

PHI ALPHA THETA, *national history honor society*: A pale blue and red cord is worn around the neck. Members represent excellence in historical research at all levels: undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate.

PHI ETA SIGMA, *national honor society*: A black and gold cord worn around the neck. To qualify, students must have a 3.50 institutional grade-point average at the close of any full-time semester during their first year.

PHI KAPPA PHI, *honorary scholastic society*:

A gold medallion with blue ribbon is worn around the neck. Members are chosen from among those students in the top 10 percent of their class.

PHI UPSILON OMICRON (PHI U), *honorary Human Development and Education society*:

Double cords of entwined purple, white and yellow are worn around the neck. Academic achievement must be within the top 35 percent of majors in the field who qualify for membership.

PI SIGMA ALPHA, *national political science honor society*:

A cloissonné, medallion on a red ribbon, is worn around the neck. To qualify, students must have a cumulative grade-point average of 3.0 and have a 3.0 grade-point average in all political science courses.

PI TAU SIGMA, *international mechanical*

engineering honor society: A white stole with the Pi Tau Sigma coat of arms is worn around the neck. To qualify, juniors in the mechanical engineering program must be in the top 25 percent of their class; as non-graduating seniors, members must be in the top 35 percent of their class.

PSI CHI, *national psychology honor society*:

A silver stole is worn around the neck. To qualify, members must have a 3.0 cumulative grade-point average, a 3.50 major grade-point average and rank in the upper 35 percent of their class.

RHO CHI SOCIETY, *national pharmacy honor*

society: A purple and white honor cord is worn around the neck. To qualify, members must have completed their second year of the professional program. Membership is offered to the top 20 percent of the class.

SIGMA THETA TAU, *international honor*

society of nursing: An orchid and white cord is worn around the neck. To qualify, members must have a 3.0 grade-point average, rank in the upper 35 percent of their nursing class, and meet the expectation of academic integrity.

SIGMA TAU DELTA, *international english honor*

society: A red stole is worn around the neck.

Undergraduate members must rank in the top 35 percent of their class. Graduate members must have at least a 3.3 grade-point average.

TAU BETA PI, *national engineering honor society*:

A white satin collar with the Bent embroidered in gold is worn around the neck. To qualify as juniors, members must be in the top one-eighth of their engineering class; as seniors, members must be in the top one-fifth of their engineering class.

TAU SIGMA DELTA, *national architecture honor*

society: A white stole with gold embroidery is worn around the neck. To qualify, juniors or seniors must have a 3.0 grade-point average and be in the upper 20 percent of their class.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM.

A gold medallion on a green ribbon is worn around the neck. Honors Program graduates have completed, in addition to their primary majors, a four-year curriculum of interdisciplinary honors courses and have produced and publically presented a senior honors thesis.

UPSILON PI EPSILON, *national computer science*

honor society: Medallion with burgundy ribbon is worn around the neck. To qualify, undergraduate students must be upperclass status in the top 35 percent of their class and have a minimum grade-point average of 3.3, with at least a 3.5 grade-point average in 24 or more credits of computer science courses. Graduate students must have at least 18 upper division computer science credits with a minimum grade-point average of 3.5.

North Dakota had been a state a little less than a year when Governor John Miller signed a bill on March 8, 1890, designating a square mile of land adjoining Fargo as the site of the new campus and demonstration farm under the name, North Dakota Agricultural College (NDAC).

A commitment to the federal government was honored by establishing a college of agriculture and mechanic arts under the Morrill Act of 1862. The course of studies was to be a “Harmonious blend of technical and academic subjects.”

Known as a “people’s college,” NDSU was part of a bold new experiment to provide access to a college education for the common person. That was how it started.
