She also convenes the University System's five community college presidents on a regular basis to address policy issues that impact two-year institutions. Dr. Krotseng has over 20 years experience in higher education planning, research, and decision-making at both the campus and system levels, including working with faculty, staff, students, campus executives, legislators, and other external stakeholders. Her background includes positions at Valdosta State University in Georgia, West Liberty State College in West Virginia, the State College and University Systems of West Virginia, Cleveland State University, and the University of Hartford. Dr. Krotseng is a member of the Executive Board for the American Council on Education's OWHE State Network. She is a past President of the national Association for Institutional Research and has served as a board member for a number of professional and civic organizations.
