About the NDSU LGBTQ Student Scholarship Fund

The LGBTQ Student Scholarship Fund was founded in 2009 by North Dakota State University faculty, staff, administrators, and alumni. The fund recognizes students' affirmation of LGBTQ identification and/or service and leadership to the LGBTQ community. Award amounts are \$500.

Eligibility

- Enrolled at North Dakota State University during the full 2013-2014 academic year
- Must have completed at least one (1) semester at NDSU
- LGBTQ identified and/or leadership or service in the LGBTQ community
- Satisfactory academic progress
- Preference will be given to those applicants who have not already received this scholarship

Applications sought from persons of diverse backgrounds, particularly those from traditionally underrepresented communities and demographic groups.

Award Terms

- To be applied to tuition, books, and/or fees through Financial Aid
- Valid only for the 2013-2014 academic year
- Award will be reported to the Financial Aid as a scholarship

Judging Criteria

- Applicants' affirmation of LGBTQ identity and/or commitment to the LGBTQ community
- Evidence of LGBT-related service, leadership or scholarship
- Evidence of serving, leading and working for change in LGBTQ communities, including as a role model, mentor, and/or adviser. (No applicant will be eliminated from consideration due to lack of opportunities to participate in LGBTQ activities).
