- Develop new competencies


In the fields of observation chance favors only the prepared mind.

## **Masters Degrees**


- Number of master's degrees in the U.S. increased over 43% in the past decade
- 75% of graduate students enrolled
- 90% of graduate degrees awarded
- Number of occupations requiring a master's degree will increase by ~20% over next decade

- "The United States must find ways to nurture a broader and more diverse talent pool to be successful in the knowledge-based economy."




FIGURE 9-2 China and European Union production of science and engineering doctorates compared with US production, 1975-2010.








## **Good for Society**
