This scholarship, funded through generous contributions of NDSU faculty, staff, administrators, and alumni, will be awarded to a student veteran who has provided service and leadership to the other student veterans in the campus community. Award amounts are up to \$500.

**Eligibility**

- Enrolled at North Dakota State University during the full 2013-2014 academic year
- Must have completed at least one (1) semester at NDSU
- Satisfactory academic progress
- Must provide a copy of DD 214
- Preference will be given to those applicants who have not already received this scholarship

Applications sought from persons of diverse backgrounds, particularly those from traditionally underrepresented communities and demographic groups.

**Award Terms**

- To be applied to tuition, books, and/or fees through Financial Aid
- Valid only for the 2013-2014 academic year
- Award will be reported to the Financial Aid as a scholarship

**Judging Criteria**

- Applicants' identification as a U.S. veteran
- Evidence of significant service and leadership, including as a role model, mentor, and/or adviser.
