Employment/Internship Opportunities

University of Iowa 2013 Summer Research Experience Undergraduates in Microbiology

The University of Iowa Department of Microbiology invites qualified undergraduate students in microbiology and other biological sciences to apply to our Summer Research Experience for Undergraduates in Microbiology. We anticipate offering fellowships to 8-10 applicants who wish to participate in ten weeks of microbiology research and are interested in pursuing graduate school and a career in biological research. Participants will conduct research on a project they select under the supervision of a faculty member. The programs will begin on Tuesday, May 28, 2013, and end on Friday, August 2, 2013.

Eligibility

Students who are citizens or permanent residents of the United States and who will have, by June 2013, completed their sophomore or junior year toward a bachelor's degree in a biological science are eligible to apply. This program seeks to improve diversity in the biological sciences. Disabled students, underrepresented minority students, and disadvantaged students (economically or first in family to attend college) are especially encouraged to apply.

Financial Support

Each student will receive a \$5,000 stipend plus a food allowance. The program also pays for housing in the Mayflower dormitory. Funds are also available for travel to and from Iowa City and for 2 semester hours of academic credit.
