AGA Investing in the Future Student Research Fellowship **Application Deadline February 15, 2013**

The American Gastroenterological Association (AGA) Research Foundation is offering a new award – the **AGA Investing in the Future Student Research Fellowship** to support under-represented minority undergraduate or medical students in a summer fellowship in digestive disease or nutrition research for eight to 10 weeks. This summer fellowship offers 10 awards of \$5,000 each to stimulate interest in digestive disease and nutrition-related research among under-represented minority students. These awards can be used for travel, housing and stipend. Eligible candidates include African Americans, Hispanic/Latino Americans, American Indians, Alaska Natives and Natives of U.S. Pacific Islands.
