- To apply, a student must have completed a minimum of 45 credit hours upon application.
- To apply, a student must have achieved a minimum GPA of 2.75 in all coursework (this includes any transfer work).
- Complete 9 credit hours in required courses (CJ 201, CJ 210, and CJ 230) with a grade of 'C' or better.
- Only one re-take of any minor course is allowed.
- Failure to maintain a minimum GPA of 3.00 in the minor courses for criminal justice will result in an academic warning issued from the department for the first violation. Students will receive notification of this warning at their NDSU email address. If the GPA falls below 3.00 for a second semester in the minor CJ courses, the student will be administratively removed from the program.
