Graduation Requirements for All Students:

- Minimum credits required to graduate = 122
- Cumulative Grade Point Average = 2.00
- 37 credits of 300-400 level coursework required
- Last 30 credits earned in residency at NDSU

Transfer Student Graduation Requirements (in addition to those listed for all students):

- Minimum of 60 credits at a 4-year institution
- Of the 60: 36 must be NDSU residency credits
- Of the 36: 15 credits must be at the 300-400 level
- 15 credits must be in the chosen major

Proficiency Waiver:

- *Piano proficiency exam must be completed before student teaching.
- *Piano credit requirements listed may be waived in whole or in part for successful completion of the piano proficiency.
- *Piano majors may fulfill this requirement by accompanying or performance on a secondary medium according to the discretion of the student's applied instructor/advisor.
