**ELECTIVES: 12 Credits**

An additional 12 crs of 300-400 level business administration (BUSN), finance (FIN), management (MGMT) or marketing (MRKT) courses; credits may include MIS 320. Departmental approval is required for any course not completed at NDSU and used to satisfy the minor requirements (6 credit maximum). A minor in business administration requires a minimum of 24 credits. Students must earn a 2.50 minimum grade point average, which is based upon the courses used to satisfy the minor requirements.
