University Village Antenna Service

University Village Antenna Service – The basic antenna service provided for University Village will no longer be paid for by NDSU after May 30, 2008.

This means that if there are problems with your TV reception after this date it will be your responsibility to have this repair made. The reason for this is because of the transition to digital in February, 2009.

TV sets that currently receive programming through cable or satellite are not likely to be affected by the transition. However, TV sets that rely on "over the air" broadcasting with an antenna (set-top or rooftop) to receive a signal will be affected by the cutoff of analog broadcasts in 2009. You will need to consider one of the following options:

Purchase a digital-to-analog converter box that plugs into an existing television. The boxes, which are expected to cost \$40-70 will be available for purchase in 2008.

Beginning in February 2008, U.S. households can request up to two coupons valued at \$40 each. Each coupon can go toward the purchase of a single set-top converter box that will allow you to

continue watching FREE "over-the-air" television on an analog set. Subscribe to cable, satellite or telecommunications service provider if all desired local broadcast stations are carried by that service. Purchase a new television set with a built in digital tuner.

Checking Out?

The end of the semester is approaching and along with the termination of classes comes the process of checking out for many students. It is very important that you pay close attention to the guidelines and procedures associated with checking out. Here are a few things to know in order to make sure that your check-out goes smoothly.

1. **Give a 60-day notice to the Residence Life Office.** Many students miss this step and are charged a fee for not planning properly.
2. **Call your Complex Manager as soon as you know the date that you would like to check-out.** There is a very large number of students who are checking out around the same time as you. Because it is the end of

the year, you will want to make sure that you get the time you are looking for.

3. **Clean Your Apartment Thoroughly.** It is crucial that you clean your entire apartment from top to bottom. You will be charged for cleaning when necessary. Some commonly missed areas are the oven, the vents, and underneath the fridge and stove.
4. **Make sure that all roommates are present at the time of check-out.** If even one roommate cannot be there, you **MUST** find a new time that works for all of you as well as your Complex Manager.
5. **If you have an internet modem, make sure all the chords are there.** There are three chords in all that should be there when you check-out.
