Bicycle Theft in University Apartments

As weather has become warmer during the spring and now the summer, there have been reports of bicycles stolen from the bicycle racks in University Apartments.

The following reminders and suggestions are given to help prevent the theft of your bicycle:

- Register your bicycle with the City of Fargo Police Department. Please call the Police Department Crime Prevention at 701-241-1345 for further information on registration. This will prevent crime as well as help identify your bicycle if it is stolen.

- Record the serial number of your bicycle and store it in a safe place. This number can normally be found on the bottom side of the bicycle.
- The best and immediate protection that you can use to deter the theft of your bicycle is to purchase a kryptonite-type bicycle lock. These are referred to as V-shaped locks, and can be purchased at Target, Wal-Mart or sporting goods stores. Prices for these locks vary depending on the type purchased.
- Do not leave your bicycle unattended in front of your apartment.
- Report any suspicious activities/stolen bicycles to the NDSU Police at 231-8998.

Bicycle Removal

- On June 11, 2008 at 8:00A.M., we will begin to remove from the racks, bicycles that are inoperable and a safety hazard.
- Everyone will need to remove their bicycle from the racks before 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday June 11th, 2008.
- From this time on, we will be removing the abandoned bicycles from the racks.
- This process will take most of the day so please do not place your bicycles back on the racks until 3:00 p.m.

- Any and all bicycles remaining in the racks after 8:00 p.m. will have the locks cut and the bicycles stored.
- Any bicycles collected will be held for two weeks before being disposed of.
- If you have any questions, please contact Residence Life at 231-7557.
- If the weather is bad on the 11th, the removal will take place on the 12th.

We really need everyone's help on this issue. The two major areas of garbage disasters in the on-campus apartment communities are the dumpsters and the open grassy areas.

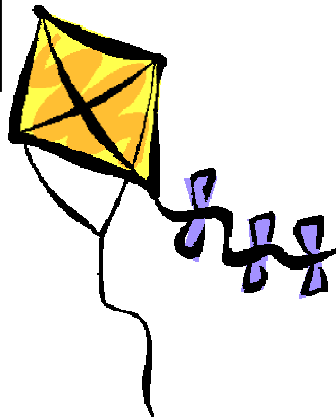
For dumpster situations:

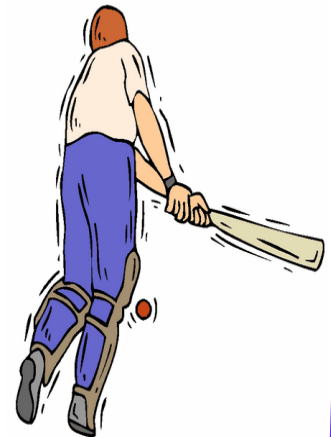
up all bags of garbage and to place them all the way into the dumpsters. This will help in the prevention of the second disaster.
