- 7.3 University Athletics (Sharon Morgan) They meet last week:
 - The hockey arena was discussed, there are three sites being proposed.
 They are proposing extending the "Dome Tax" for 5 years to pay for an arena.
 The arena would be used for both Men and Women Hockey at NDSU.
 Looking at doing a ticket campaign to try to generate some money up front.
 - The NCAA is moving to three year contracts for coaches, as contracts come up, NDSU will also be moving to this.
 - The University Senate would like to eliminate University Athletics as a "Standing Committee" because University Athletics does not make policy, the committee feels that athletics needs to be involved in the University and is part of the University. The committee would like the committee to remain.
 - There will be two more meetings before May.
 - Amy Ruley has been elected to the North Dakota State Hall of Fame as a professional person. On June 10th there will be a banquet in Jamestown.
