Active membership requires current enrollment in THEA 201, 202, 203, 204, 370, or 450. Students must be on the official course roster to be considered active. New members are considered apprentices and given one complimentary ticket for every LCT production. The rank of active members is raised for every two semesters of work completed. With each increase of rank an additional complimentary ticket is given. The list of active members will be generated each time a LCT program is prepared. Students who register after that time may still receive their complimentary tickets by providing the EBP coordinator (Prof. Rooth Varland) proof of registration in a qualifying course.

Summary:

Apprentice = first and second semesters = 1 complimentary ticket

Journeyman = third and fourth semesters = 2 complimentary tickets

Artist = fifth and sixth = 3 complimentary tickets

Master Artist = seventh and above = 4 complimentary tickets

Complimentary Tickets

Complimentary tickets are available through the LCT Box Office ONLY (and should be arranged for prior to the day of the show). Each cast member/production crew member is entitled to at least one complimentary ticket to the current production (Note: Edwin Booth Players info above). Cast and running crew may purchase tickets and/or reserve complimentary tickets during regular box office hours only. Ticket orders will not be accepted on performance nights (no exceptions). **DO NOT COME TO THE BOX OFFICE IN MAKEUP AND/OR COSTUME AND EXPECT TO GET TICKETS.**
