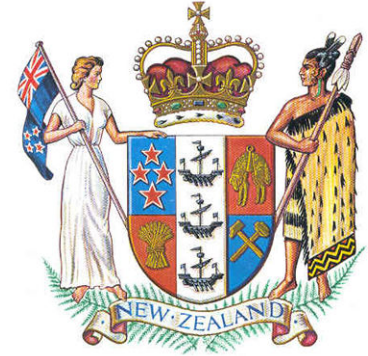


Travel Grants for Graduate Presenters New Zealand & Australian Studies Section Western Social Science Association

The Department of History at North Dakota State University, a significant provider of college coursework on Australia and New Zealand, offers two travel grants for graduate students presenting papers in the New Zealand & Australian Studies Section of the Western Social Science Association. Graduate students from anywhere are eligible for these grants.



Papers will be presented at the annual meeting of the section in Albuquerque, New Mexico, 15-18 April 2009.

The grants will be awarded to the first two graduate students whose papers are accepted for publication by Bill Schaniel, Coordinator of the New Zealand & Australian Studies Section. Students seeking grants should indicate to Dr. Schaniel that should they receive such, they will have adequate support or resources to attend the meeting and present their papers.

How to Apply

Simply submit a paper proposal to the section coordinator, indicating intent and support to attend the meeting and present the paper if a travel grant is received. The first two graduate presenters accepted will receive travel grants.
