

Tough soldiers in the making

Coming out of the

Chinese military scougo through fire and water to ake it

As 50 soldiers with painted red and black faces scramble out of the forest, it is difficult to tell one from the other.

They are all from a scouting group in the Hainan Military Area and have been strictly trained in mountain, forest and sea combat under the cruel sunshine in Hainan Province, where they have undergone training for six months.

"We all look like we've just come out of a jungle in Africa," said 33-year-old group commander, Liu Fei, who is the oldest in the group. Most of his soldiers are around 20 years old.

The soldiers have to study and learn seven subjects during their stay, which include scouting and anti-scouting land operations, conquering obstacles, passing through swamps while carrying logs, passing through fire, diving and combating under water. All of these activities that require great stamina are selected from a noted international military contest called "Ernaretk," which was initiated by Estonian Military in 1992.

The summer and autumn months in Hainan are hot and wet and are similar to a tropical rainforest climate, a rare climate in most of China.

Passing through the fire ring is the most difficult task out of all of the activities that the soldiers must take on. During the entire movement, both the soldier's head and the gun he is holding must both be directly ahead and he must shoot continuously. The fire usually singes their skin.

The intensely difficult training has managed to toughen up the group quite considerably. Yang Tongxiao and Yang Fan, both 21, came in as runner-ups in the China "Ernaretk" Contest held




