

How the New M.Arch. Curriculum Affects YOU

- ◆ **If you are currently a first year student**
 1. You will be following the new curriculum without exception.

- ◆ **If you are currently a second year student**
 1. You will be following the new curriculum with the following exceptions:
 - a) If you have taken Math 165 or higher, you will not be required to take Math 105.
 - b) Arch 231 Architectural Drawing will be an optional course in the fall semester of your third year.
 - c) Arch 326 Design Theory will be taken in the fall semester of your third year.

- ◆ **If you are currently a third year student**
 1. You will be following the new curriculum with the following exceptions:
 - a) If you have taken Math 165 or higher, you will not be required to take Math 105.
 - b) You will not be required to take Arch 231 Architectural Drawing, but you may take it as an elective course.

- ◆ **If you are currently a fourth year B.Arch. student**
 1. You will be following the old curriculum.

- ◆ **If you are currently a fourth year M.Arch. student**
 1. You will be following the new curriculum with the following exceptions:
 - a) If you have taken Math 165 or higher, you will not be required to take Math 105.
 - b) You will not be required to take Arch 231 Architectural Drawing.
 - c) Arch 461 Urban Design will be an optional course in the Spring of 2006.
 - d) You will be required to have 170 credits to graduate.

- ◆ **If you are currently a fifth year B.Arch. student**
 1. You will be following the old curriculum with the following exception:
 - a) You will not be required to take Arch 299 Digital Media/Environmental Technology.

- ◆ **If you are currently a fifth year M.Arch. student**
 1. You will be following the old curriculum with the following exceptions:
 - a) You will not be required to take Arch 299 Digital Media/Environmental Technology.
 - b) You will be required to take 2 Arch 72x History/Theory Topic Seminars and 2 Arch 789 Professional Topics Seminars.
 - c) Your sixth year classes will be re-numbered graduate level classes.
 - d) You will be required to have 170 credits to graduate.

Comments:

1. Where a course is not required or optional, you will be required to make up those credits with elective credits.
2. Many courses have been re-numbered. Use course names to make comparisons between the old and new curriculum.
3. Some courses have increased in credit value. Those courses, previously taken, will not convert to the higher credit value. Those credits must be made up with elective credits.
