
Benefits of CSO Recognition

Temporary Status Benefits:

1. Use of Memorial Union for recruiting purposes
2. Opportunities to hang posters in Memorial Union/reserve rooms
3. Participating in the Student Organization Fair
4. Mailbox Assignment in the Student Activities Office

Full Status Benefits:

1. Usage of any facility on Campus
2. Campus & Community Promotion of your Organization
3. Usage of the Student-ANNOUNCE listserv
4. Usage of Motor Pool
5. Registering a website on campus
6. Participating in the Student Organization Fair
7. Establish Tri-College entities
8. Usage of Community Facilities
9. Receive Funding based on Finance Guidelines
10. Request Mailing Lists for sending out info about your organization's events
11. Be included on the list of student organizations available to prospective and current students

Probationary Status:

1. Restricted from using any facility on campus, West Fargo, or the Fargo-Moorhead area for one full semester
2. All mail sent to advisor/acting advisor
3. Must meet with the CSO Commission before being reinstated.
4. If you are found to be violating these probations, the commission will not recognize your organization for a period of no longer than three years. This will be effective from the date of discovery.
5. Any events that the organization sponsors cannot take place on or off campus without a temporary waiver or meeting with the Conflict Resolution Board.
