In accordance with the provision of Section 19 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 read with Section 26 of the said Act the Governor of Assam pleased to appoint A. J. C. (Revenue), Kamrup District to be the collector to enquire into and determine the existence, nature and extent of rights (if any) existing in favor of any person or persons; in or over any land comprised therein within the limit as described in the schedule annex thereto and to deal with such claims as prescribed in Chapter IV of the Wildlife (protection) Act, 1972.
