Daytrip to Hillsboro, Mayville and Tortland

Travel Itinerary

- 1. Leave Fargo Heading North on I-29
- 2. Take exit 104 to Hillsboro

Restroom and Information Center located approx. 39 min. north of Fargo

Hillsboro Trip

- 3. Head east on CR 11 to Trail Country Museum at 308 W Caledonia Ave. Spend 1 hour or more walking and touring museum
- Continue east on CR 11 to Courthouse at 114 W. Caledonia Ave.
 Spend 30 min viewing memorial and interior of City Hall
- Make way to Historic Main Street by continuing east on CR 11
 Spend 1 hour or more shopping and walking around historic district
- 6. Tour the Hillsboro historical homes. Maps can be found at the Traill County Museum. Spend 30 min. to 2 hours viewing homes.
- 7. Make way to Pioneer Park by heading west on Caledonia to 6th St, turn south. Spend 30 min. or more touring replica historic village and other buildings from the late 1870's
- 8. After spending roughly 3+ hours in Hillsboro, ND travel North on I-29 and exit 111, head West on CR 200 approx. 13 miles to Mayville.

Mayville/Portland Trip

- 9. Make way to Mayville State University by heading north on 5th Ave. Spend 20 min. touring and/or traveling through campus
- 10. Travel to Historical Library by heading south on 2nd Ave NE to 2nd St NW, Lirbrary loacate at corner of Center Avenue and 2 St. NW Spend 10 to 30 min. touring building
- 11. Walk across Center Ave. to Faye's Henhouse Quilts. Spend 30 min. to 3 hours looking at quilts or join a class
- 12. Upon leaving town on CR 200 to the West make a quick stop at the Rainbow Garden and Pioneer Park. Spend 1 hour to 2 hours walking through Garden, great Picnic area along the Goose River

Heading back to Fargo you can turn around and follow same path back, or Take Country Road 18 south from Mayville to Interstate 94 south of Casselton. Then head East on Interstate 94 to Fargo. This trip will be longer and have more of a rural setting.

Suggestions to See

Places We Suggest Not Missing out on:

We suggest taking the time to fully tour and walk through the Traill County Museum. The fully restored and furbished 1897 mansion will keep visitors intrigued with the vast amounts of artifacts and historic items that can be viewed. Along with the Museum, visitors have the option to follow a guided map through Hillsboro to look at the other historical homes in town.

While in Hillsboro, we also suggest taking the time to dine at the locally run Country Hearth Restauarant. With breakfast specials and other meals being very reasonable priced, it would be a shame to miss out on this home cooking.

After taking time to dine in Hillsboro, we suggest traveling a block to the south to visit Pioneer Park. This park is home to multiple replicas of historic buildings from the late 1870's including: St. Olaf Chapel, a log home and a school house.

While visiting Mayville we suggest stopping at the Rainbow Garden on the west side of town that is linked up with the Willowwod Campground located along the Goose River. The river and garden provide an excalent site for small gatherings and picnicing.




