

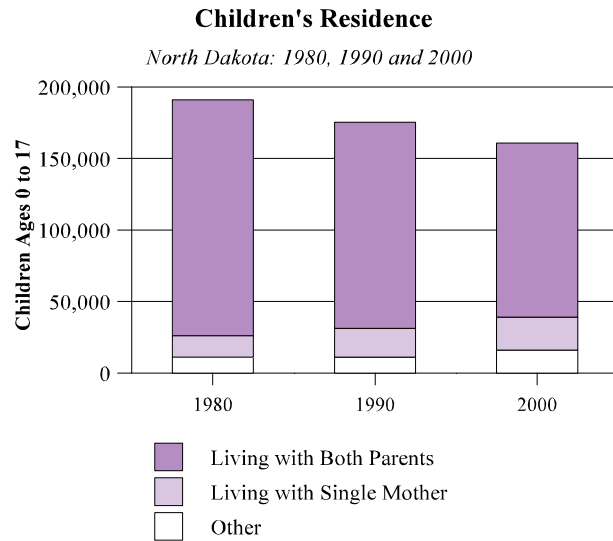
Living Arrangements of Children in North Dakota: 2000

According to the 2000 Census, children ages 0 to 17 totaled 160,849 in North Dakota. Of these children, a majority (99.6 percent) lived in households. The remaining 0.4 percent (675 persons) resided in group quarter facilities.

The majority (75 percent) of North Dakota children under age 18 lived with both parents in 2000. Approximately 14 percent lived with their single mother and 4.7 percent lived with their single father.

A small but growing proportion of children in North Dakota live with their grandparents. In 1990, 2,628 children under age 18 lived with their grandparents. This number rose 48 percent to 3,901 in 2000.

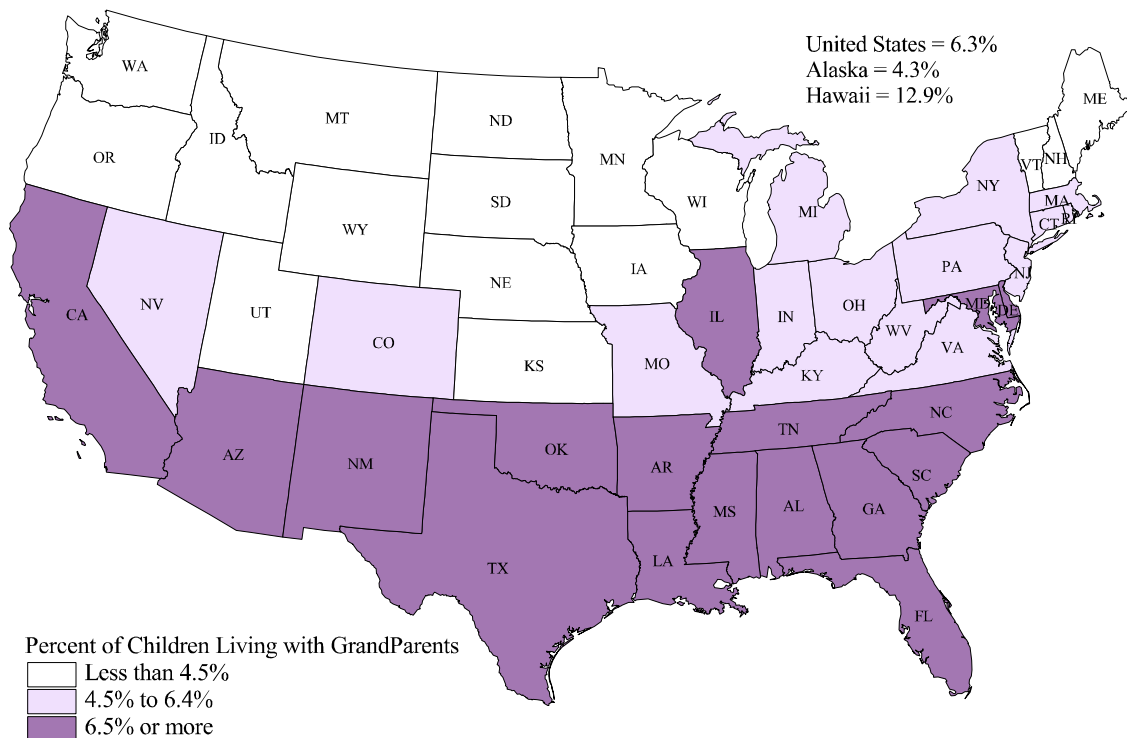
Nationally, North Dakota had the lowest proportion of children ages 0 to 17 living with their grandparents (2.4 percent).
