

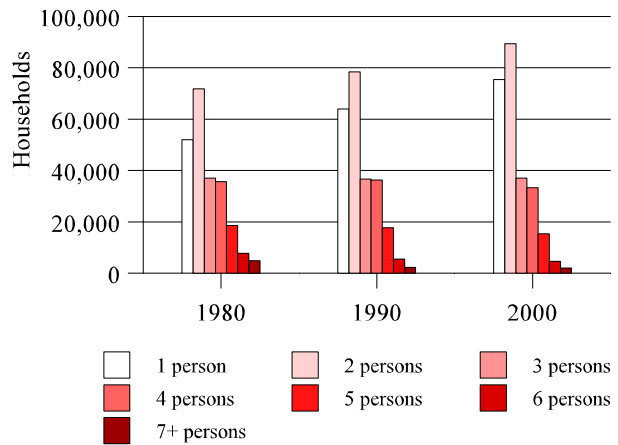
Household Size in North Dakota: 2000

According to the 2000 Census, North Dakota had a total of 257,152 households. Of these households, nearly two-thirds (64.1 percent) were comprised of one or two persons only.

The number of one and two-person households in North Dakota rose 33 percent between 1980 and 2000. Thus, the average households size declined from 2.75 persons per household in 1980 to 2.41 in 2000. Nationally, North Dakota had the third lowest proportion of persons per household in 2000.

Reservation counties, in general, had the largest households in North Dakota. Sioux County ranked first in the state, averaging 3.6 persons per household in 2000. Nearly one-third of all households in Sioux County had five or more persons.

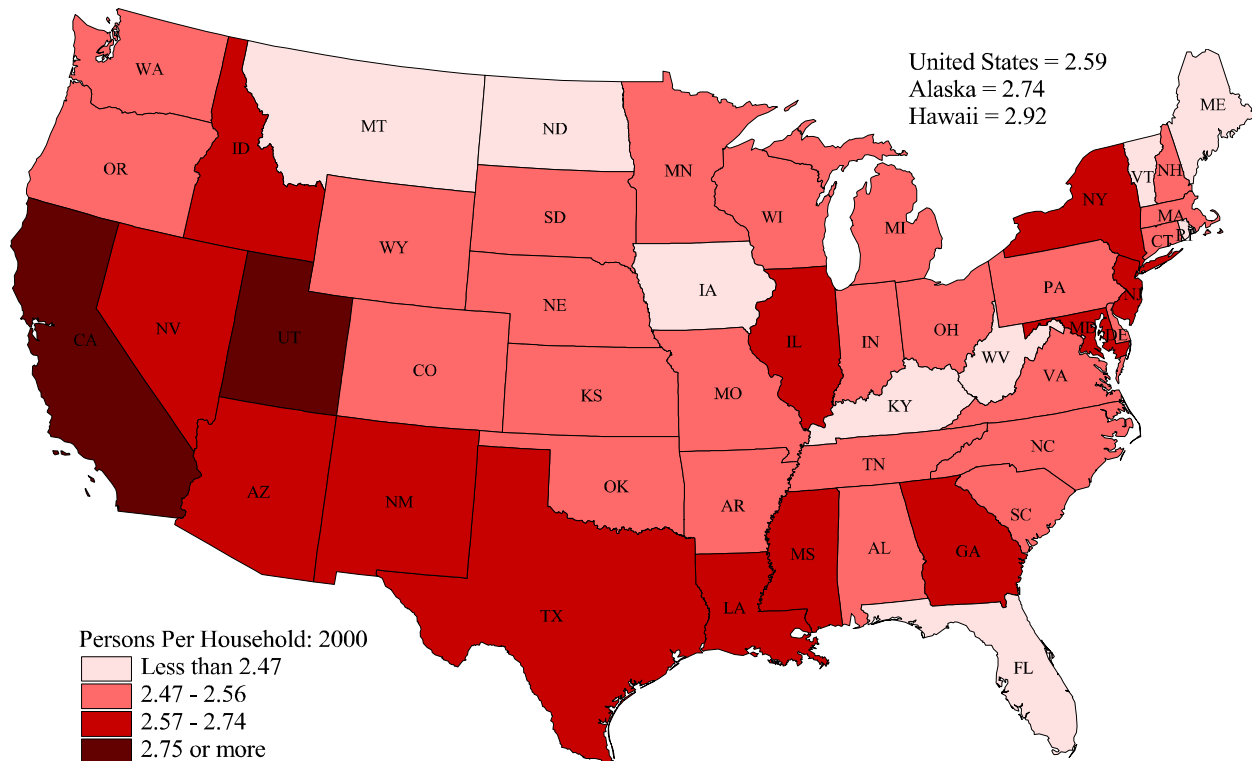
Households by Household Size in North Dakota
