Homecoming 2022 is approaching faster than many of us realize so it's time to start thinking about whom would best represent your organization as prospective Homecoming Royalty Candidates. Each organization on campus is eligible to nominate two individuals. Please keep in mind that applicants must be in good academic standing, and should be a committed, enthusiastic, and positive representative of both your organization and NDSU as a whole. As you may remember, last year we removed the titles of Homecoming King and Queen and replaced it with Homecoming Royalty. We intend to do this again this year. We will be crowning Homecoming Royalty which will be determined by the two top individuals based on the student body voting. We are also going to be accepting nominations of all undergraduate students.

Attached you will find two applications, one for each of the candidates you are nominating. **The application deadline is Monday, September 12 at 5pm.** Applications can be dropped off in the Student Activities Office, Room 120 of the Memorial Union. Please schedule your organization's nominations early enough to ensure your nominees will have adequate time to complete and submit the application. No late applications will be accepted. When the applications are turned in, nominees are to sign up for their interview. Interviews **for all candidates will be held Wednesday, September 14.** Interviews will be held from 4:00 to 10:00 pm and will take place in either the Heine Room or the Dinwoodie-Bjornson Room, both in the Student Activities Area of the Memorial Union. Photos of all applicants will be taken before interviews. Professional attire is recommended.

Twelve Royalty candidates, will be selected as the 2022 NDSU Homecoming Court by a committee comprised of NDSU faculty, staff, students, and alumni. These candidates will be expected to actively participate in the Homecoming week activities as well as both the Homecoming Parade and Bison Pep Rally & Ice Cream Social Monday afternoon (9/26).

The results will be posted at 9am on Friday, September 16, in the Student Activities Office. **All finalists will be required to meet with the Homecoming Coronation Committee on Friday, September 23 from 4 – 5pm in the Student Activities Office of the Memorial Union.**
