Application for admission to the interdisciplinary internet web design program

This 21-credit interdisciplinary program emphasizes theory and skills needed to manage internet web content and delivery. Students complete a twelve-credit core covering design concepts, software tools, coding languages and applied projects. Students also choose nine credits of electives from options in design, scripting, programming, digital media, management, theory, or independent study. An internship is required. The program is coordinated through the communication department; students must apply for admission to this limited-enrollment program. Prerequisite for admission: CSCI 116, Business Use of Computers.
