The 2023-2024 Dakota Fall Ram Test will be held at the Hettinger Research Extension Center in Hettinger, ND. Christopher Schauer and Dave Pearson will serve as the test managers.

Cost. The cost per ram is \$325 due upon delivery at the test site. Please add \$16/hd if you do not have your DNA testing done, we will test them. Depending on where feed prices go, we may have to ask for more \$ at the end of the test to cover the feed bill, but I hope not. PLEASE CONTACT ME AND LET ME KNOW HOW MANY RAMS YOU PLAN ON BRINGING. OUR NEW RAM TEST FACILITY SHOULD BE COMPLETED BY EARLY NOVEMBER, BUT I WOULD LIKE AN IDEA OF HOW MANY HEAD ARE COMING, ESPECIALLY IF YOU ARE A NEW CONSIGNOR TO THE TEST. This will cover feed, management, veterinary attention, and wool testing. Wool from the Ram Test to help cover shearing costs.

<u>Health</u>. Rams will be vaccinated against enterotoxemia and sore mouth shortly after arrival. All rams will be drenched for internal parasites. <u>Please indicate on your entry form if rams have been vaccinated for any of the above or if they have been drenched.</u>

In order to comply with North Dakota health regulations, all rams will be tested for <u>Brucella ovis</u> (ELISA) at the end of the performance test. Lambs over 6 months of age at the beginning of the test must be tested for <u>B. Ovis</u> before they can be accepted in the station or originate from a certified <u>B. Ovis</u> free flock. <u>All animals must be accompanied by COMPLETED TEST ENTRY FORM, health papers, and originate from a footrot and scrapie free flock. Federal I.D. tag must be in animal's ear and listed in the health paper.</u>

REGULATIONS FOR 2023-2024 DAKOTA FALL RAM TEST

- 1. Ram lambs will be delivered to the test site by September 17, 2023.
- 2. Rams will be shorn, weighed, and will start the official test on September 21.
- 3. Individual fleeces will be shorn and sampled on February 9. Samples will be used to determine staple length (adj. for 365 days), clean yield and fiber diameter. Samples will be sent to Texas A&M University for yield and fiber analysis (OFDA).
- 4. Feed. The rams will be self-fed a mixed ration containing a commercial protein supplement, oats, corn, and alfalfa pellets.

- 5. Liability. All animals remain the property of the cooperator. The manager will make every effort to take proper care of the animal and to provide proper veterinary services, but it will not be responsible for any losses occurring during the test. In the event of a major health problem, the appropriate cooperator will be contacted on direction for disposal. If a ram is removed from test for health reason, or dies while on test, a partial refund of the entry fee will be made.
- 6. Feeding and management of the rams on test will be under the supervision of Dave Pearson and Christopher Schauer.

RAMBOUILLET RAM OWNERS

- 1. For Rambouillet rams consigned all necessary procedures and rules for establishing Certified Rams and Registry of Merit sires will be followed.
- 2. All Rambouillet rams <u>must be registered no later than 60 days after the test starts</u> to be eligible as Certified rams. If you do not have registration numbers on rams when you send in your entry forms, please send them to us as soon as you get them.
- 3. If a Rambouillet entered in the Certified Sire Program qualifies as a Certified ram, he <u>must</u> be classified with the American Rambouillet Association as a Certified ram. The owner will be billed for the \$15.00 classification fee, as this program has been set up to carry itself without additional cost to the ram test.
- 4. Breeders submitting rams for testing should submit a statement containing their **INTENTION OF ENTERING RAMS IN THE CERTIFIED SIRE PROGRAM BEFORE** the testing begins and list birth dates accompanying the flock or ear tag numbers. For ARSA certification program eligibility rams must genotype QR or RR at codon 171; QQ rams are not eligible for certification. **The genotype information must be included on the "Test Entry Form".**

COLUMBIA RAMS AND OTHER BREEDS CONSIGNED

All data will be collected based on the Rambouillet Certified Ram program, but breeds will be separate. The Rambouillet Index will NOT be used. Certification criteria are up to the individual breed associations. All health requirements are the same. DNA testing is not required, but can be done upon request.
