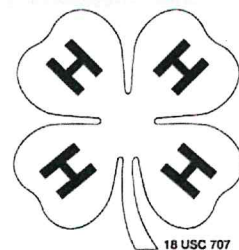

Examples of Suggested Equipment



Participants with **Dogs** must bring their own kennel or holding container and close-toed shoes. Dogs should be well-mannered and in good condition/healthy. Not required to be groomed or bathed. Attendees are also responsible for watering their animal(s) and bringing applicable supplies you might need for showmanship and obedience. Recommended dog show leads include(see examples pictured above):

For Showmanship practice and Fair –A leather or nylon adjustable slip leash/collar to use as a single piece or a two-piece set. As a two-piece set the collar portion can be chain, cord or leather.

For Obedience practice and show - a 6ft leash is standard equipment for any obedience work, pleasure hikes and general dog handling in public. A slip chain or slip collar should be used in conjunction with the 6ft leash.

Notes on products to avoid: a chain leash, plastic snaps/connectors, added handles.
