# **Minutes of the State Soil Conservation Committee Meeting**

#### **New Business:**

- Legislative Budget Bill Update
  - Carrie Johnson gave a brief update on the legislative budget bill that affects NDSU Extension and the SSCC (SB2020). NDSU Extension budget is 2.1% less, but the amount allocated to SCDs (DART) is the same as in the previous biennium (\$1.3 million). The additional requested \$150,000 was not adopted by the legislature.
- Discuss DART Rankings
  - A thorough discussion regarding DART rankings ensued.
    - Committee members expressed concerns that old rankings may have been used to weight the algorithm used in the DART system, which may skew current rankings.
    - Discussion of how SCDs can move up in the current ranking.
    - Thorough discussion of mill levies and whether SCDs are leveraging enough.
    - Several options for determining rankings going forward were discussed.
  - Carrie noted that we can create a spreadsheet that includes the factors the SSCC wants to consider when looking at rankings.
  - No changes will be needed to the DART system; Sarah Tunge will be informed.
  - Kelly made a motion of continuance to gather more information. Bob seconded. No further discussion.
     Motion carried.
    - Carrie will share the aforementioned spreadsheet via email, and the Committee will vote via email on whether to use that or not.
