The North Dakota 4-H Program has offered camping as educational experience since 1967. Programs are designed to develop life skills for safe and healthful living, enhance personal development and provide constructive uses of leisure time. We are committed to providing a safe environment where youth can make new friends and develop new skills.

Our facilities include a main dining hall, an educational center with showering facilities, Butler Outpost multipurpose building and three sleeping cabins. The camp has walking trails along the Missouri River and lots of open spaces to enjoy.

Our staff members are trained in outdoor skills, science, agriculture and human development to work with youth to ensure a high-quality experience for campers.

In addition to the planned education program, recreational opportunities are included for each camp. Campers enjoy many activities, including our walking trails, fishing pond, kayaking and archery. Campers especially like the evening campfires, waterslide and a dance.

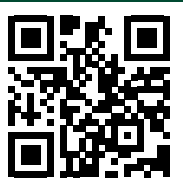

● Livestock Camp

May 26–30 Ages: 8-18 Cost: \$375

Learn how to show and fit your livestock in preparation for your county fair or achievement day! Learn to groom, clip and show a variety of livestock. Participants will learn about proper ways of feeding and selecting competitive livestock projects. A showmanship contest will be held and awards will be given. We will test participants knowledge of livestock with quiz bowl activities. Campers are encouraged to bring their own animals (no rabbits or poultry). You will be able to note which species to bring during online registration.

● Head & Heart Resilience Camp

May 31–June 4 Ages: 8-12 Cost: \$375

Through fun and interactive activities, youth will explore positive ways to build resilience and manage stress. Youth will learn to recognize sources of stress and understand how stress feels in their bodies and minds. Campers will leave with greater confidence and practical tools to support their mental and emotional well-being.

● Creative Arts

May 31–June 4 Ages: 10-12 Cost: \$375

There will be no macaroni art found at this camp! Become an artisan in various fields. Campers will develop skills that can be used in projects throughout their lives. Develop new hobbies and interests. Go home with finished products that can be entered into local, district, and state fairs. ● Clover Camp I

June 4–5 Ages: 5-9 Cost: \$200

Campers will also spend extensive time on the outdoor range, applying advanced techniques to real-world shooting scenarios and learning to adapt to varying distances and conditions. Whether you're preparing for competition or striving for personal growth, this camp will challenge and empower you to reach your full potential as an archer.

Prerequisite: Prior archery experience and familiarity with basic range safety and shooting fundamentals are required.

● Adventure Camp I

Throughout the camp, youth will learn essential kitchen skills, including knife handling, meal planning and food safety. ● Outdoor Skills with Hunter Education Camp

August 2–6 Ages: 11-14 Cost: \$375

This camp fulfills the requirement of the North Dakota Hunter Education Certification; all campers will participate in classroom-style sessions and live fire sessions in shotgun, muzzle loader and archery. There is required work to complete before camp begins. Information will be mailed out to participants. The required hours of Hunter Education instruction are a minimum of 14 hours. Learn basic survival and first aid skills. Learn basic trapping skills and tree stand safety.

● Wildlife Camp

August 2–6 Ages: 10-14 Cost: \$375

Campers can expect to be immersed in information about creatures ranging from the very tiny to the largest fur-bearing animals in North Dakota. Campers will enjoy hikes, experiments and creature adaptations to learn what makes them unique.

● Holiday Arts and Crafts Camp

August 9–12 Ages: 10-15 Cost: \$375

From spooky ghosts to holiday ornaments, this camp has it all! You won't find any macaroni art here — instead, you'll become an artisan exploring a variety of creative crafts. Acquire hands-on skills that you can apply to future projects and explore new hobbies and interests. Throughout camp, we'll decorate cookies, complete a woodburning project, create a painting, and dive into many other fun and festive art activities. Check-in starts at 10 a.m. on Oct. 17 and ends at 11 a.m. on Oct. 18.

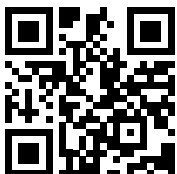
Get your spooky on! We will participate in various craft projects, including creating Frankenstein, pool noodle art, a porch mummy, Halloween party snacks and a costume party!
