Re: Napoleon FFA Alumni agronomy, livestock, & ag sales event

The Napoleon FFA Alumni is sponsoring its 16th annual FFA & 4-H livestock, agronomy and ag sales event on January 31st, 2026. Registration for the livestock judging will be held at the salesbarn which is on the north side of town along Highway 3 beginning at 8:00. Registration for agronomy and ag sales will be at the school (615 3rd St E) and specifically in the gym lobby which is located on the south side of the school. Lunch and awards will be held at the school. Tabulations as well as the coffee and rolls will be in the Ag room. Yes, we will have coffee and rolls at the sales barn as well!

There are no limits on the number of contestants per chapter/county but for FFA you will need to register your members in teams, with a **maximum of five members per team for FFA. 4-H will simply need to indicate junior and senior teams.** We will be using the judging card scantron for tabulations so please familiarize your students with it as well as what their chapter/county number is. Registration is **\$10.00 per judge** which will include lunch; we will not charge coaches as we hope everyone assists with some aspect of the event.

If I could get **tentative numbers by January 19th** that would be great for planning. A simple, we are planning to attend and have approximately 15 participating.

Followed by accurately registering your contestants by name by January 28th. Registration packets will be prepared ahead of the morning registration for each event, so accurate pre-registration is absolutely necessary. Update me as necessary so registration is accurate and we aren't making a lot of changes the morning of.

8:00 to 8:45----Registration for all events at locations noted above

8:45 to 9:00----Instructions for the day

9:00-----Start time for all events; livestock judging will be at the Napoleon Livestock Auction; the agronomy cde will take place in the school gym; and ag sales will be held in the Napoleon High School. Livestock judges will begin reasons immediately following judging at the salesbarn and will be served lunch at the school upon completion of reasons.

In the event of a weather cancellation, listen to KSJB radio (600 AM) or the KX network. I would also send an email early that morning.
