Lieutenant Colonel Jason R. Evans is the Commander of Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 610 at both North Dakota State University in Fargo, ND and the University of North Dakota in Grand Forks, ND. Detachment 610 trains and commissions officers into the Air Force and Space Force to serve in a wide variety of career fields, from pilots to intelligence, space, and engineers.

Lieutenant Colonel Evans is originally from Hartford, Ohio and was commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corps program in 2002 at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Florida. After graduating from Pilot Training in 2003, Lieutenant Colonel Evans flew the C-21A Learjet transporting senior military and civilian leaders throughout United States. During his next assignment, he served as Wing Executive Officer while flying the KC-10A Extender on worldwide refueling, contingency and cargo missions based out of Joint Base McGuire Dix Lakehurst, NJ.



Following his selection for the Phoenix Reach program, Lieutenant Colonel Evans began an assignment flying the C-17A Globemaster III on worldwide contingency and cargo missions and served as the Chief of the Wing Commander's Action Group. He completed the Joint Mobility Fellow program at Scott AFB, IL in 2014 followed by a joint officer assignment at U.S. Transportation Command. In June 2018, he completed his squadron command tour at the 32d Air Refueling Squadron. He is a command pilot with more than 4,400 flying hours, including over 1,400 combat hours.
