Representation on College Committees is as follows:

Humanities (English; History, Philosophy, and Religious Studies; Modern Languages) - 2 members

Social Sciences (Communication; Criminal Justice and Political Science; Emergency Management; Sociology and Anthropology) - 2 members

Fine Arts (Architecture, Landscape Architecture; Music; Theatre Arts; Visual Art) - 2 members

No more than one person from a department shall be on any committee at any time. Moreover, no tenure track faculty member will serve on more than one college committee at any given time during his or her probationary period.

Senior lecturers in AHSS are eligible to serve on the Curriculum Committee and the Student Progress Committee. Each of these Committees may have only one senior lecturer among its members, and each senior lecturer may serve on only one of these committees at any given time. With regard to nomination, area representation, and length of service, the stipulations applying to faculty members also apply to senior lecturers. In addition to being eligible to service on the aforementioned college committees, senior lecturers are eligible to participate fully in all aspects of governance pertaining to these committees (e.g. vote on curriculum proposals) in college meetings.
