Declared, pre-professional medical laboratory science (MLS) students who are enrolled at NDSU and will be eligible to apply Fall 2017 to affiliated hospital-based programs for the 11-12 month professional program "internship" will receive an NDSU email invitation in early August to attend this important meeting. The informational meeting will include an overview of the application process and admission criteria for each hospital.

Student eligibility requirements to apply for the professional internship are:

- 1. Declared pre-professional MLS major at NDSU;
- 2. Plan of study on file with the department that verifies the student's ability to complete all courses on campus by start of an internship, including 20 resident credits at NDSU for transfer students;
- 3. Earned a minimum GPA (2.50-3.00) as required by the hospital program by the internship application deadline;
- 4. Earned a minimum of "C" in all courses used to fulfill major and degree requirements;
- Meet the program-designated essential functions (mental and physical requirements), or request reasonable accommodations to meet the essential functions;
- 6. Comply with criminal background and student conduct requirements.
