Awards range from \$200 to \$700. You can apply for multiple scholarships at once. Please check the box next to the scholarship(s) to which you are applying.

- Dr. G. Arthur Larson Memorial Fund.** Must be a legal resident of North Dakota or Minnesota, and pursuing a pre-medicine program of study.
- John B. Ries and Frank Startz Families Scholarship.** For a pre-medicine student in good standing, who demonstrates a love of medicine.
- Dr. Velva E. Rudd Scholarship Award.** For Botany juniors or seniors in good standing.
- Dr. O. A. Stevens Memorial Scholarship.** For outstanding seniors, based on academic achievement and character as exemplified by Dr. Stevens, a true naturalist.
- Dr. A. D. Stoesz Memorial Scholarship Award.** For junior or seniors with an interest in ecology or environmental science who demonstrate good morals, leadership ability, human understanding and academic interests.
- Dr. Warren C. Whitman Outstanding Botany Student Award.** For outstanding seniors who have demonstrated academic achievement and performance in the study of plants (does not have to be a Botany Major)
