DEGREE REQUIREMENTS AND NOTES:

1. Students follow the published curricula for the major program of study from the semester/year of entrance in the College of Business to graduation, provided enrollment at NDSU has not been discontinued for more than one year. Students who change their major program of study are subject to meeting the curricular requirements in effect at the time the new major is declared.
2. Business courses from programs that do not hold AACSB International accreditation cannot be used for major or minor requirements in the College of Business (CoB); such courses may be eligible for use as free electives.
3. The CoB will accept up to 49% of AACSB transfer credits from the following course prefixes: ACCT, BUSN, FIN, MGMT, MRKT, MIS, ENTR, SCM.
4. Admission into the Supply Chain Management major (i.e., completion of the pre-admission requirements 2.50 cumulative grade point average) is required to enroll in 300-400 level accounting, business, finance, management, management information systems, supply chain management and marketing courses. A letter grade must be earned in any course that fulfills a major requirement with the exception of some practicum options.
5. Students must be accepted into the major prior to the completion of the last 30 credits in required 300-400 level College of Business courses.
6. Students must earn a 2.50 institutional GPA to graduate.
7. For multiple majors within the College of Business, at least 15 unique credits of 300-400 level College of Business courses must exist between the majors.
