### DEGREE REQUIREMENTS AND NOTES:

1. Students follow the published curricula for the major program of study from the semester/year of entrance in the College of Business to graduation, provided enrollment at NDSU has not been discontinued for more than one year. Students who change their major program of study are subject to meeting the curricular requirements in effect at the time the new major is declared.
2. Business courses from programs that do not hold AACSB International accreditation cannot be used for major or minor requirements in the College of Business (CoB); such courses may be eligible for use as free electives.
3. The CoB accepts a maximum of nine credits of non-NDSU 300-400 level business courses from AACSB programs with approval of the department.
4. A grade of 'C' or better is required in transfer courses accepted for all accounting, business administration, finance, management, management information systems, and marketing courses.
5. Students must earn a 2.50 institutional GPA and complete all course and credit requirements to graduate with a major in Business Administration.
6. Admission into the Business Administration major and a 2.50 cumulative grade point average is required to enroll in 300-400 level accounting, business administration, finance, management, management information systems and marketing courses. A letter grade must be earned in any course that fulfills a major requirement.
7. Students must be accepted to the business administration major prior to the completion of the **last 30 credits** in 300 and 400 level CoB courses.
8. Of the credits completed in residence, at least 30 credits must be in the 300-400 level CoB courses.
9. No courses for the major may be taken with Pass/Fail grading.
10. For multiple majors within the College of Business, at least 15 unique credits of 300-400 level College of Business courses must exist between the majors.

12. Internship and cooperative education credits may be applied toward the total credits required for graduation as non-major electives.
