Students must earn a letter grade of C or better, and have a minimum 2.5 culumative GPA, in ALL courses included in the professional program (i.e., all required courses, electives, and additionall 300-400 level CoB electives or breadth electives).

## **DEGREE REQUIREMENTS AND NOTES:**

- 1. Students follow the published curricula for the major program of study from the semster/year of entrance in the College of Business to graduation, provided enrollment at NDSU has not been discontinued for more than one year. Students who change their major program of study are subject to meeting the curricular requirements in effect at the time the new major is declared.
- 2. Business courses from programs that do not hold AACSB International accreditation cannot be used for major or minor requirements in the College of Business (CoB); such courses may be eligible for use as free electives.
- 3. The CoB accepts a maximum or nine credits of non-NDSU 300-400 level business courses from AACSB programs with approval of the department.
- 4. Admission into the Finance major (i.e., completion of the pre-admission requirements and a 2.50 cumulative grade point average) is required to enroll in 300-400 level accounting, business, finance, management, management information systems, and marketing courses. A letter grade must be earned in any course that fulfills a major requirement with the exception of FIN 397 and FIN 413.
- 5. Students must earn a 2.50 institutional GPA to graduate.
- 6. Students must be accepted to the finance major prior to the completion of the last 30 credits in 300 and 400 level accounting, business adminstration, finance, management, management information system and marketing courses.
- 7. A Business Administration minor is NOT offered with this major.
- 8. For multiple majors within the College of Business, at least 15 unique credits of 300-400 level College of Business courses must exist between the majors.
