DEGREE REQUIREMENTS AND NOTES:

- Students must have a first major in Accounting, Business Administration, Finance, Management, Management Information Systems, or Marketing. The Global Business major is a second major only. Students may only actively pursue the Global Business major after being admitted to the professional program (the same requirement for all College of Business majors).
- Denotes Common Body of Knowledge (CBK) course.
- The intent of this core requirement is to ensure that the study abroad experience includes an academic component related to the country where the experience takes place. In addition to BUSN 341, BUSN 394 will fulfill this requirement. 379 courses from across campus and other study abroad transfer courses approved by the Department Chair will also fulfill this requirement. While these courses will fulfill the academic requirement portion of the study abroad experience, the student must study abroad for at least 3 weeks. In some cases, the study abroad requirement is fulfilled by one study abroad experience - e.g., a five-week program in Europe or a full semester abroad. However, two shorter programs may be substituted for a longer program (e.g., the 10-day CoB spring break experience in Eastern Europe and the 12-day CoB summer trip to China).
- Completion of any 300- or 400-level language course with a B or higher will also fill this requirement. For non-native English speakers, completion of any 300-400 level ENGL course with a grade of B or higher, including ENGL 320, will fulfill this requirement.
- Students must follow the published curricula for the major program of study from the semester/year of entrance in the College of Business to graduation, provided enrollment at NDSU has not been discontinued for more than one year. Students who change their major program of study are subject to meeting the curricular requirements in effect at the time the new major is declared.
- Students enter the College of Business as a pre-major student. Admission to the major program requires an application indicating the successful completion of the pre-major and college courses with a "C" or higher, a 2.50 institutional cumulative grade point average, and a minimum of 60 credits.
- Students must complete all course and credit requirements for a second major in global business.
- A 2.50 cumulative grade point average is required to enroll in 300-400 level accounting, business administration, finance, leadership, management, management information systems, and marketing courses. A letter grade must be earned in any course that fulfills a major requirement.
- Students must earn a 2.50 institutional GPA to graduate.
- Of the credits completed in residence at least 30 credits must be in 300-400 level accounting, business administration, finance, leadership, management, management information system and marketing courses. As such, students must also be accepted to the major prior to the completion of the last 30 credits.
