

North Dakota Annual cash receipts by commodity 2019














North Dakota Livestock Numbers

- ND is 9th largest beef cow state
- ND beef cows increased 20,000 head in 2019 while neighboring MN,MT,SD declined
- ND beef cows increased 126,000 head 2010-2020
- ND total cattle numbers up 70,000 head 2019 to 2020
- ND breeding hogs similar to neighboring MT and WY but less than Corn Belt states
- ND breeding ewes increased 13.9% during 2019-the largest % increase in the US, while neighboring states declined






CHANGE IN BEEF COWS 2019 TO 2020



CHANGE IN BEEF COWS 2010 TO 2020




DECEMBER 1 BREEDING HOGS AND PIGS 2019







TOTAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION







JANUARY 1 BEEF COW INVENTORY












QTRLY GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP)


Real Dollar (2012) Change from Previous Quarter







US PORK EXPORTS TO CHINA (MAINLAND)




2020 Market Share of Imported Beef Business in China.



CALF CROP




MED. FRAME #1 STEER CALF PRICES 550-600 Pounds, N.D., Weekly







2021 CATTLE PRICES BACK TO 2018 LEVELS AND INCREASING AVERAGE ANNUAL CATTLE PRICES




FEEDER LAMB PRICES

Northern Plains 60-80 lbs. Weekly




SLAUGHTER LAMB PRICES

Northern Plains, Weekly




LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION

Federally Inspected, Weekly




LAMB AND YEARLING DRESSED WEIGHT


BASE SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES

National, Weighted Average Carcass Price, Weekly




FEEDER PIG PRICES


EARLY WEANED PIG PRICES


BROILER PRICES

National Composite (Whole Bird), Weekly




WHOLESALE CHICKEN WING PRICES




WHOLESALE CHICKEN BREAST PRICES

WHOLESALE CHICKEN LEG QUARTER PRICES




Prices Received for Milk by Month - United States




