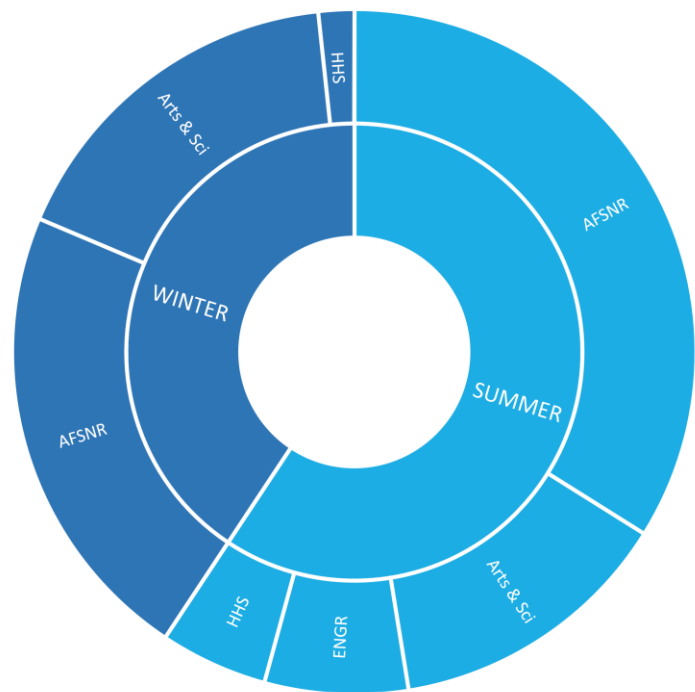

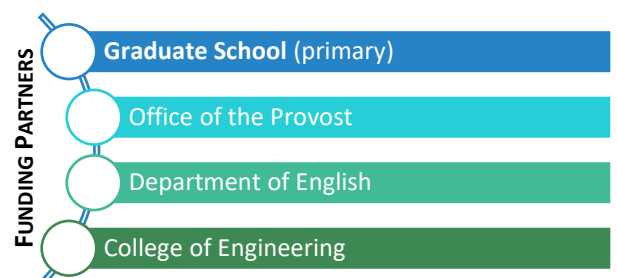
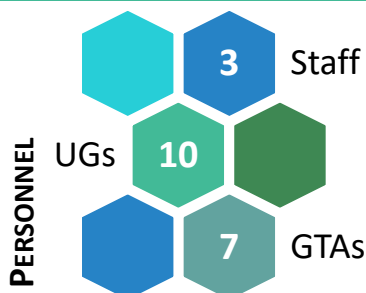

### *Context Notes for 2022-2023 At-a-Glance*

- Data comes from WC Online, CFW internal records, MyNDSU, and Campus Connection
- NDSU Transform and college mergers occurred in July 2023 (note college identifications are different in charts, a remnant of ways data were collected)
- Mary Pull, long-time administrator for the CFW, was the Interim Director in Fall 2022
- Stephen Disrud, new to the CFW, hired as the Director starting in January 2023
- \*LANG 709 taught in Fall 2022 when S Disrud was a Lecturer in Modern Languages
- \*\*LANG 406/606 supported by Grad School in summer session; Fall 2022 taught in Modern Languages
- \*\*\*LANG 704 scheduled and enrolled in Spring 2023 but dropped from the schedule to refit S Disrud's allocation of effort
- With the exceptions of ENGL 752 and LANG 406/606, all courses taught by S Disrud
