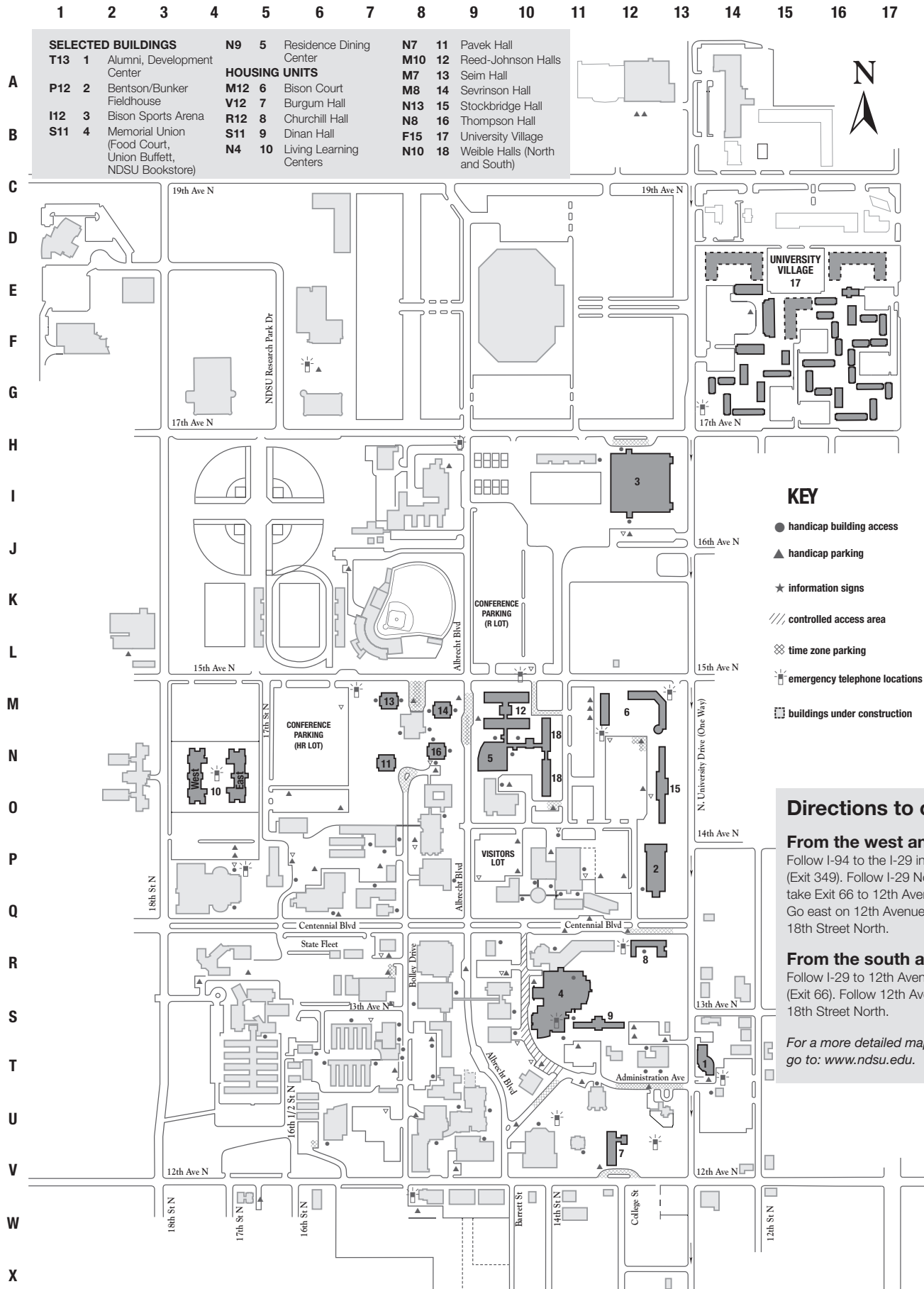
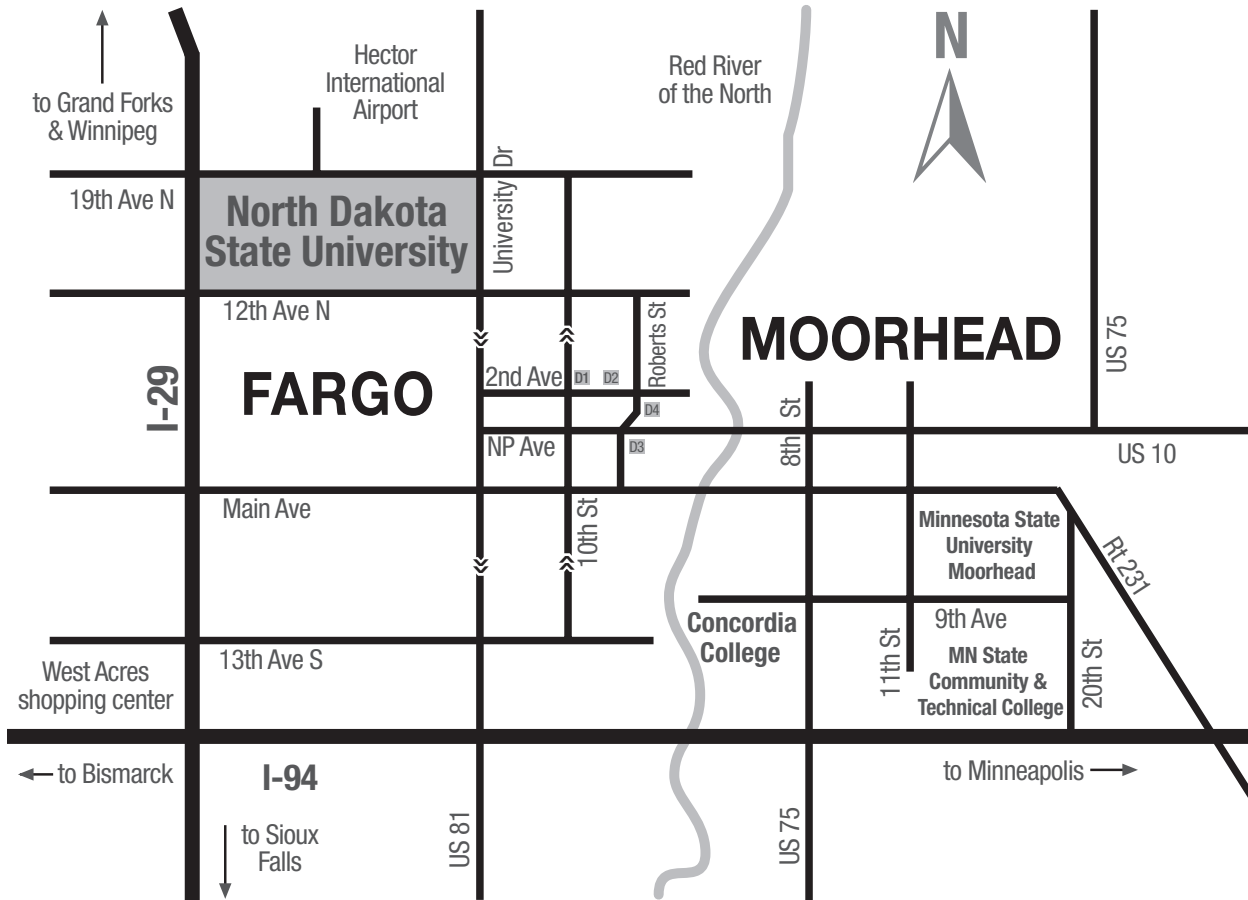

## campus map

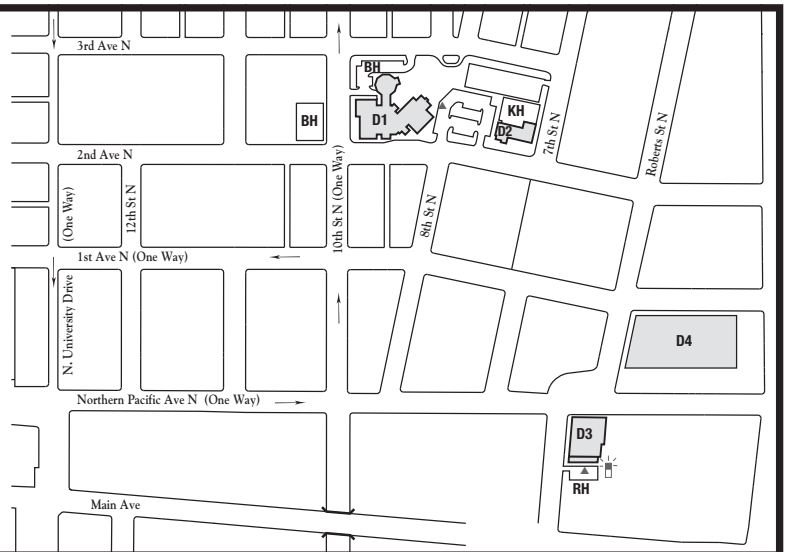


# FARGO/MOORHEAD AREA MAP

### A growing university

NDSU is a land-grant university accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, with an enrollment of more than 14,000 students. Education resources for NDSU students include cutting-edge technology and a highly educated faculty with 66 percent of all faculty members holding the highest degrees in their fields. NDSU is part of the Tri-College University, which allows students enrolled at NDSU to take courses at Concordia College and Minnesota State University Moorhead at no additional cost.

### A thriving community

NDSU is located on the eastern edge of North Dakota in Fargo, the state's largest community. With its sister city, Moorhead, Minn., directly across the Red River, Fargo forms one of the largest metropolitan centers between Minneapolis and Seattle. Forbes.com listed NDSU and Fargo as number five in an article called "Top College Towns for Jobs." Fargo-Moorhead topped a list of 72 areas studied and ranked by the Earth Day Network for environmental health.
