- The boundaries for zip code 58442 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- In 1990, zip code 58442 encompassed most of the northeast quadrant of Logan County with 867 residents. A boundary change in 2000 restricted the territory in Logan County to the far northeast corner but included part of the southwest corner of Stutsman County. The new area had 554 residents in 2000.
- Logan County experienced a decline in population between 1990 and 2000. Population projections for Logan County indicate that population declines are likely to continue over the next two decades.
- In 2000, 14 percent of residents in zip code 58442 were under 20 years of age and 41 percent of residents were ages 65 years and older. This is a very different age profile from Logan County in which youth comprised 24 percent of residents and elderly comprised 27 percent of the population in 2000. Projections for Logan County indicate stability in the proportion of youth and an increase in the proportion of elderly over the next two decades.
- In 2000, nearly all residents in both zip code 58442 and Logan County were white.

- The boundaries for zip code 58442 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- Logan County experienced a decline in total housing units between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, approximately two-thirds of housing units were owner-occupied in both zip code 58442 and Logan County.
- Vacant housing units declined in Logan County between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, the vacancy rate was 19 percent in Logan County and 26 percent in zip code 58442.
- In 2000, the median value of an owner-occupied home in zip code 58442 was \$28,100, compared to \$30,200 in Logan County.
- In 2000, half of all housing units in zip code 58442 were built before 1954; half of all housing units in Logan County were built before 1957.

- The boundaries for zip code 58442 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The median household income in zip code 58442 was \$24,231 in 2000, compared to \$27,986 in Logan County. When the 1990 median values are adjusted for inflation, the 2000 median household income represents an increase in purchasing power for Logan County residents.
- The proportion of impoverished residents declined in Logan County between 1990 and 2000. Nonetheless, 15 percent of all residents in both Logan County and zip code 58442 were impoverished in 2000.
- Logan County saw a decline in the number of impoverished children between 1990 and 2000 and a slight increase in the number of impoverished elderly. In 2000, 25 percent of impoverished residents in Logan County were children and 33 percent were elderly. In contrast, 9 percent of those living in poverty in zip code 58442 were children and 59 percent were elderly in 2000.

- Logan County reported 30 deaths in 2005, down from 32 in 2002. Major contributors to death were heart disease and cancer.

- In 2000, the unemployment rate was 2.9 percent in Logan County and 4.5 percent in zip code 58442.

- The boundaries for zip code 58442 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- Total employment declined in Logan County between 1990 and 2000.
- The proportion of employed that was female increased in Logan County between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, females comprised 43 percent of all employed in both zip code 58442 and Logan County.
- Between 1990 and 2000, Logan County experienced declines in agricultural and retail trade employment and growth in manufacturing and service industry employment. In 2000, the service sector was the largest industry in both zip code 58442 and Logan County, employing approximately one-third of the workers in both areas.

- The K-12 enrollment for Gackle-Streeter Public School District totaled 116 students in 2004-2005, down from 165 in 2001-2002.

- In 2004-2005, 80 percent of students in the Gackle-Streeter Public School District were proficient or advanced in reading, up from 53 percent in 2001-2002. In addition, 79 percent of students were proficient or advanced in math in 2004-2005, up from 20 percent in 2001-2002.
