# About the Amanda Weitgenant Memorial LGBTQ Student Scholarship Fund

The Amanda Weitgenant Memorial LGBTQ Student Scholarship Fund was founded in 2009 by North Dakota State University faculty, staff, administrators, and alumni. The fund recognizes students' affirmation of LGBTQ identification and/or service and leadership to the LGBTQ community. Award amounts are \$500 – two scholarships will be awarded this year.

### **Eligibility**

- Enrolled at North Dakota State University during the full 2015-2016 academic year
- Must have completed at least one (1) semester at NDSU
- LGBTQ identified and/or leadership or service in the LGBTQ community
- Satisfactory academic progress
- Preference will be given to those applicants who have not already received this scholarship

Applications sought from persons of diverse backgrounds, particularly those from traditionally underrepresented communities and demographic groups.

#### **Award Terms**

- To be applied to tuition, books, and/or fees through Financial Aid
- Valid only for the 2015-2016 academic year
- Award will be reported to Student Financial Services as a scholarship

## **Judging Criteria**

- Applicants' affirmation of LGBTQ identity and/or commitment to the LGBTQ community
- Evidence of LGBTQ-related service, leadership, or scholarship
- Evidence of serving, leading and working for change in LGBTQ communities, including as a role model, mentor, and/or adviser. (No applicant will be eliminated from consideration due to lack of opportunities to participate in LGBTQ activities).
