\_\_\_\_\_the Inside Address is correct and adheres to the guidelines

\_\_\_\_\_the Salutation is correct and adheres to the guidelines

\_\_\_\_\_the Body is correct and adheres to the guidelines

\_\_\_\_\_the Complimentary Closing is correct and adheres to the guidelines

\_\_\_\_\_the Writer's Signature Block is correct and adheres to the guidelines

### **Letter-Content (see pages 454-455 in Handbook of Technical Writing on informal reports in a letter)**

\_\_\_\_\_the introduction announces the subject of the report, states its purpose and gives any other essential background information

\_\_\_\_\_the body of the letter presents a clearly organized account of the report's subject-the information you gathered about your community and other details the reader may need.

\_\_\_\_\_the conclusion summarizes your findings and interprets their significance for the reader.  
(NOTE: Recommendations for the reader or suggestions for a course of action can also be included in the conclusion but these elements are not required because they weren't stated in the instructions for this assignment.)
