Nominations may be submitted by faculty, staff, students, alumni, and administrators (*see below for more information*). *Self-nominations will be accepted to ensure that there are multiple and inclusive pathways to nomination*. Nomination materials should be sent by email to NDSU Provost, ndsu.provost@ndsu.edu. Nominations must include a nomination letter (no more than two pages) or nomination form, accompanied by a curriculum vitae (no more than three pages), and should clearly describe how the nominee meets the award criteria (*see below for nomination materials for each award*). <p>Phi Kappa Phi Faculty Lectureship Award Deadline: 10/6/2023</p>	<p>Recognizes faculty whose outstanding, high impact research, scholarship, or creative activity consistently supports NDSU’s top tier research status and who have a proven ability to effectively present their research to a broad community in the land grant tradition. Lectureship will be held in December 2023. Award amount: \$2,500 (<i>up to two finalists receive \$500</i>). <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), 2-3 finalists will be interviewed.</p>
<p>Walter F. and Verna Gehrts Presidential Professorship Deadline: 10/27/23</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and service. Eligibility: Associate professor with at least 5 years of service to NDSU. Award amount: \$6,500. <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long).</p>
<p>Faculty Lectureship Award Deadline: 12/8/2023</p>	<p>One of the oldest and most prestigious of the faculty awards, recognizes sustained excellence in teaching, scholarly achievement, and service. Lectureship will be held in April 2024. Award amount: \$2,500 (<i>up to two finalists receive \$500</i>). <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), 2-3 finalists will be interviewed.</p>

<p><u>Odney Excellence in Teaching Award</u> Deadline: 1/26/2024</p>	<p>Honors faculty who have consistently demonstrated outstanding teaching and has made positive contributions to the educational experience of NDSU students. <i>Students, alumni submit nominations.</i> Award amount: \$2,500. <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination form; finalists will be asked to submit CV and a letter explaining their teaching philosophy and detailing their teaching activities.</p>
<p><u>Waldron Excellence in Research Award</u> Deadline: 1/26/2024</p>	<p>Honors faculty who have consistently demonstrated outstanding achievements and contributions to research and scholarship. Award amount: \$2,500. <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long).</p>
<p><u>Peltier Innovation in Teaching Award</u> Deadline: 1/26/2024</p>	<p>Recognizes three faculty who have used innovative teaching techniques to enhance the educational experience of NDSU students. (Three newer faculty may be recognized for their use of innovative teaching). Award amount: \$5,000 (\$1,000). <i>See award page for Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long); finalists will be asked to submit CV and a letter describing their innovative teaching techniques and detailing their teaching activities.</p>
<p><u>Excellence in Mentoring Award</u> Deadline: 2/23/2024</p>	<p>Recognizes outstanding mentoring by faculty of undergraduate/graduate students, faculty, and others. <i>Students, staff, and faculty submit nominations.</i> Award amount: \$2,500. <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), Letters of support from mentored individuals.</p>
<p><u>Chamber of Commerce NDSU Distinguished Faculty Service Award</u> Deadline: 2/23/2024</p>	<p>Recognizes faculty who have attained distinction in their profession and have made substantial service contributions to the community and region. Eligibility: Faculty holding the rank of full professor. Award amount: \$2,500. <i>See award page for list of Previous Winners.</i> Submit: Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), Letters of support (no more than two letters).</p>
<p><u>Outstanding Faculty Advisor Award</u> Deadline: 2/23/2024</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in advising by a faculty academic advisor. Eligibility: Faculty advisor at NDSU. <i>Students and alumni can nominate.</i> Award amount: \$1,000. Submit: Nomination form.</p>
<p><u>Outstanding Professional Advisor Award</u> Deadline: 2/23/2024</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in advising by a professional academic advisor. Eligibility: Professional advisor at NDSU. <i>Students and alumni can nominate.</i> Award amount: \$1,000. Submit: Nomination form.</p>

<p><u>Jordan A. Engberg Presidential Professorship</u> Deadline: 10/25/24</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and service.
